

School proficiency

This chart shows how county schools did on the end-of-grade and end-of-course READY tests. The composite score is the percent of all tests passed at each school. Elementary and middle school students were tested in math, reading and science. High school students were tested in Math I, Biology and English II. School performance grades are calculated using achievement on end-of-year tests and growth scores. Several other measures, like graduation rate and ACT scores, are added to the calculation for high-school letter grades.
