On April 6, 2024, at 8:20 a.m., I, PO III Ava Mouton, was dispatched to 600 W. Taft Street (Baker Hall) in reference to a welfare check.

Dispatch advised that she received a call from ██████████ in Houma, LA. ██████████ advised that her friend ██████████ who attends UL Lafayette University (stays in Baker Hall on the ██████████ had posted on social media that they wanted to commit suicide and jump from the Taft Parking Tower. ██████████ advised the posts were on Snapchat, and she could not provide copies due to them disappearing. Dispatch advised that she had located a ██████████ in the Cajun Card system who had scanned their card at 3:59 a.m. at Baker Hall. ██████████ identifies ██████████ as transgender and goes by ██████████. This was confirmed through social media (Instagram user ██████████) and matching the phone number provided for ██████████ in the Cajun Card System.

I went to Baker Hall along with Ofc. James Smith. We spoke with the worker at the front desk, who provided us the information that ██████████ stays in room ██████████. We went to room ██████████ where ██████████ stays. We knocked on the door several times and no one answered. We were contacted by Sgt. Michael Guidry who stated that ██████████ had left the building at 7:56 a.m. heading towards Girard Park. We left Baker Hall and checked the areas around Girard Park but were unable to locate ██████████. During this time, dispatch advised they called the phone number listed for ██████████ multiple times, but calls went straight to voicemail.

Sgt. Guidry was able to watch video surveillance which showed ██████████ leave Baker Hall and turn right onto Taft Street. Once at St. Mary BLVD, ██████████ turns right onto St. Mary and walks to Johnston Street, crossing over to the other side. ██████████ is then seen walking South on Johnston Street where ██████████ turns right on St. Julien Street. Sgt. Guidry could no longer track ██████████. Dispatch ran ██████████ name through Cajun Card again and found ██████████ had scanned ██████████ card at 8:56 a.m. into Baker Hall.

Ofc. Smith and I went back to Baker Hall to speak with ██████████. Ofc. Smith activated his body worn camera. We knocked on the door several times where ██████████ did not answer the door. The RA was contacted and met us at room ██████████ to unlock the door. The RA unlocked the door and Ofc. Smith and I entered the common area. Ofc. Smith knocked on door ██████████ and the door slightly opened. When he opened the door wider, no one was seen in the room. Ofc. Smith checked the bathroom to the left and no one was in the bathroom. I checked the bathroom on the right and while I was in there, I heard Ofc. Smith speaking with someone, asking "you didn't hear us knocking?" I walked over to the room and saw Ofc. Smith speaking with ██████████ who was located inside a closet cabinet.

██████████ was sitting across the inside bottom of the closet cabinet with ██████████ laptop on ██████████ lap and a candy cigarette in ██████████ right hand as though smoking it. ██████████ was advised why we were there. ██████████ stated, "I'm glad my friends are worried about me but I'm ok". ██████████ was asked if ██████████ wanted to hurt ██████████ or commit suicide and ██████████ stated ██████████ did not and that ██████████ was ok. ██████████ was asked if ██████████ sees a counselor or needed to speak with one and ██████████ stated ██████████ sees a private counselor once a week. ██████████ appeared to be in good health and did not show any signs of being suicidal. Prior to clearing the call, ██████████ was advised that if ██████████ needed anything further, ██████████ could contact UL Lafayette Police.

The welfare concern was also referred to the UL Lafayette counselor on call by phone and e-mail.
