At a time when chain restaurants and fast food joints are popping up like mushrooms, sometimes a down-home diner is just what the doctor ordered when your belly is grumbling.

Henderson's Family Restaurant, on East Avenue A in downtown Killeen, has been serving delicious meals since 1994.

"We love to continue the longstanding Henderson family tradition in our community," said general manager April McHenry. "It's the best home-cooking restaurant in Central Texas."

McHenry said it's more than the food that keeps folks coming back for more.

"It's all about providing a family atmosphere and home cooking for our friends and customers, all at reasonable prices," she said. "We really try to build personal relationships with our customers."

Although the atmosphere is nice and comfy, folks will not need to spend all day there, unless they just want to.

"People have commented on our extremely fast service," McHenry said. "Our staff is genuinely thoughtful. Every one of our employees is an integral part of our family."

She is thankful for her customers who keep coming back.

"Our customers continually spread the word to their friends and families, even talking about us in military bases all over the world," McHenry said.

People come from all over the region for the all-you-can-eat catfish dinner, served every Friday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m.

The restaurant supports local first responders and also those in need with their annual Free Feed the Hungry dinner

on Christmas Day. The dinner is served from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Last year was the 22nd year for the Christmas Day dinner, an event started by restaurant founder Jerry Henderson. Every year on Christmas Day, Henderson's Family Restaurant opens its doors to those in need during the holidays, to include anyone without a place to call home, seniors who may not have any living relatives, or Fort Hood soldiers lacking family or friends in the area.

Lines form out the door for the event, with around 500 people enjoying the Christmas tradition at the restaurant in 2017, and about the same last year.

For such an undertaking, the restaurant has many volunteers and help from a local church.

Lifeway Fellowship Church in Killeen has been helping the restaurant host the lunch for the past 16 years, and church members have donated bags full of important items for those in need.

Each of the holiday gift bags last year contained socks, a pair of gloves, a hat, a blanket, various toiletry items, assorted food items and even a toy for the children. Everyone who was at the meal was able

to pick up a bag, and any bags left over were donated to the Killeen homeless shelter, which would distribute the items as needed.



But a recent study from researchers at the University of London that examined how the vocabularies of more than 9,400 people developed between the ages of 16 and 42 found that vocabulary continued to improve long after teenage years. By continuing to read books from their local libraries into adulthood, adults can further develop their vocabularies.

### **Libraries provide lots of free entertainment.**

Libraries are home to thousands of books, but that's not all you can find at your local branch. Newspapers, magazines, CDs, and DVDs are some examples of the forms of entertainment available at local libraries.

# 7 WAYS NEWSPAPERS BENEFIT STUDENTS

Classrooms have come a long way since the days when pioneering settlers would send their children to single-room schoolhouses. 
