



## KILLEEN POLICE DEPARTMENT UNOFFICIAL NIBRS GROUP A STATS COMPARISON



On March 31st, 2026, the Killeen Police Department switched to a new records system called Niche. When a police department switches records systems, it must go through a testing and approval process before it can officially report crime statistics again. To get approved, the department must submit three consecutive months of statistics without any major errors. Once approved, the department can resume officially reporting crime statistics to Texas DPS and the FBI. The Killeen Police Department made this switch alongside several other agencies in Bell County. Because of how that partnership was set up, Killeen will begin its approval process after Temple Police Department completes theirs.

Because the Killeen Police Department is still working through this approval process, we are currently unable to provide official crime statistics. In the meantime, we will be providing unofficial statistics. These numbers will look different from what has been reported in the past. The National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS) counts crimes differently depending on factors like how a crime is classified, how many victims were involved, and how many locations were entered. To keep things simple and consistent, we are reporting a straight count of individual offenses per incident.

Here is exactly how those numbers are put together: All offenses are pulled from the Niche system, then cleaned up to remove any duplicates from the same incident. For example, one incident involving an assault and two drug offenses would be counted as one assault and one drug offense. Those offenses are then grouped by crime type and sorted by either the month or the running year total. Each offense is counted based on when it started, not when it was reported. So an incident that started in January but ended in March would count toward January. Likewise, an incident that started in June 2024 but was not reported until March 2026 would count toward June 2024. This maintains NIBRS standards. Once the data is gathered for both the current year and the previous year, percent change and rate per 100,000 residents are calculated using standard formulas.

The Domestic Violence Summary is put together the same way, but is filtered to only include domestic violence incidents.

Crash statistics are calculated the same way as before and were not affected by the records system change.
