Re: Request for information from Patricia S Ritch to the Village of Salado - ORR Ritch

Dear Attorney General Paxton:

This law firm represents the Village of Salado (“the Village”). Patricia S Ritch (“Requestor”) submitted the attached request (**Exhibit A**), which was sent to the Village on February 26, 2026. Ms. Ritch requests the following information:

“Pursuant to Government Code, Section 551.001, I am requesting public records, specifically: 100% Drawing set for the Royal Street Improvement Project.”

The Village has determined that certain responsive information requested may be excepted from disclosure by §§552.101, 552.110, 552.1101, 552.113, or 552.131 of the Act. The Village takes no position on whether said exceptions may apply to the information requested. (See **Exhibit B** for responsive documents). Pursuant to Government Code § 552.305(d), the Village has notified the third-party vendors involved, by separate letter, that its proprietary information may be subject to these exceptions under. See Third Party Notification letters attached as **Exhibit C**. The letter notifies the third-party vendor that it is entitled to submit the following, in writing, to the Attorney General, within a reasonable time not later than the 10th business day after the date of receipt of the letter from the Village:

1. Identify the legal exceptions that apply,
2. Identify the specific parts of each document that are covered by each exception, and
3. Explain why each exception applies. Tex. Gov’t Code §552.305(d).

The responsive information that is the subject of this letter consists of a document that is too large to submit through the electronic filing system and due to the images within the document, could not be reduced after several attempts. Thus, it is impractical for the Village to submit the responsive information through the electronic filing system because it is larger than 40MB’s and the attorney general’s designated electronic filing system cannot accept this at the time of filing.
