- Pre-Trial Monitoring:** Report to the Pretrial Release Assistance Office **within one (1) judicial day** after release from jail for intake at the Jackson County Circuit Court located at 100 S Oakdale Avenue, Medford Oregon 97501. Check-in hours are Monday – Friday 1:00pm to 4:00pm.
- Report to Probation:** Currently on supervised probation, parole, post-prison supervision. Report to supervising officer upon release at the Probation Office at 1101 West Main, Medford, OR on the next judicial day, and obey all conditions of supervision.
- Process at jail
- If the Defendant possesses a valid passport, he/she is to surrender said passport to the Pretrial Release Officer immediately
- Do not possess firearms, either actual or simulated, ammunition, weapons, or dangerous animals
- Do not consume or possess alcohol, or non-prescribed controlled substances or cannabis. You may be required to submit to a Urinalysis upon request at your own expense.
- Do not operate any motor vehicle unless properly licensed and insured
- No contact with minors
- No contact with co-defendants
- Polygraph testing (as requested) at defendant's expense to verify compliance with release conditions
- Do not possess any domestic animal
- Prohibited from being on or about the premises or property at: _____
