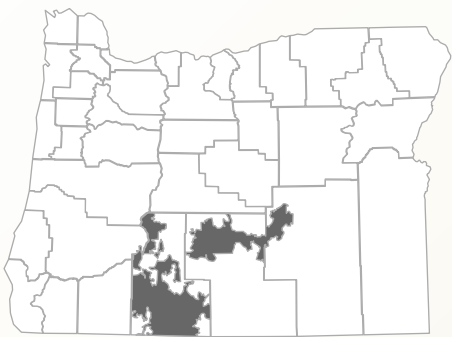

OR **491** Jobs supported

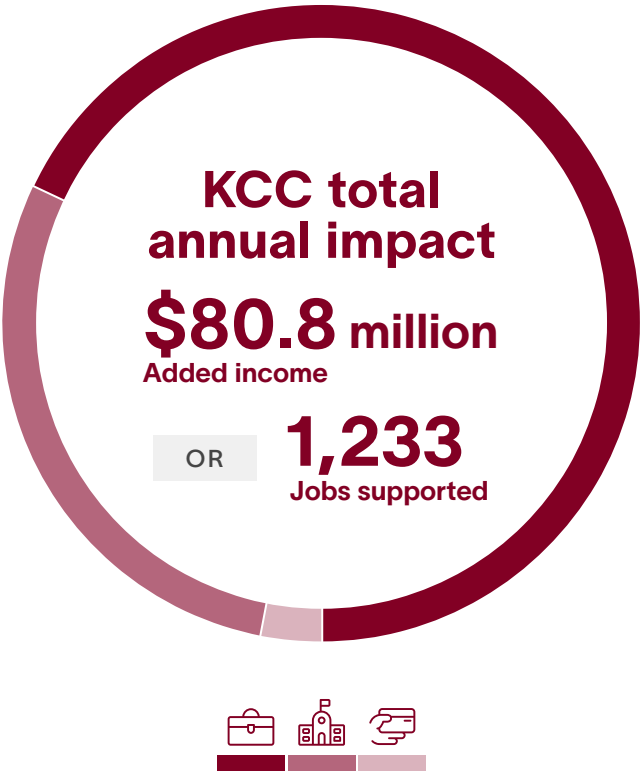


 **\$2.2 million** Added income

OR **38** Jobs supported



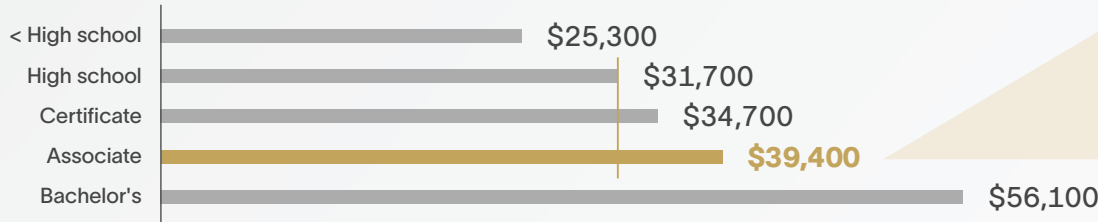

Investment analysis

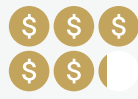


Average earnings by education level at career midpoint



The average associate degree graduate from KCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$7,700** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Oregon.

For every \$1...

Students gain **\$5.20** in higher lifetime earnings

Society gains **\$5.40** in added income and social savings

In total...

 **\$24.4 million**

Taxpayers gain in added tax revenue and public sector savings
