16 COUNT 1 FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM

17 The defendant, on or about July 3, 2023, in Jackson County, Oregon, having previously
18 been convicted in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County on April
19 24, 2012 of the felony of Manslaughter in the First Degree, did unlawfully and knowingly
20 have in said defendant's possession, custody or control a firearm.

21 COUNT 2 FLEEING OR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE A POLICE OFFICER

22 The defendant, on or about July 3, 2023, in Jackson County, Oregon, being an operator
23 of a motor vehicle upon a public highway and/or premises open to the public, and having
24 been given a visible and/or audible signal to stop by a police officer who was in uniform
and prominently displaying the police officer's badge of office or operating a vehicle
appropriately marked showing it to be an official police vehicle, did unlawfully and
knowingly, while still in the vehicle, flee and attempt to elude a pursuing police officer.

25 COUNT 3 FLEEING OR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE A POLICE OFFICER

26 The defendant, on or about July 3, 2023, in Jackson County, Oregon, being an operator
of a motor vehicle upon a public highway and/or premises open to the public, and having


1 been given a visible and/or audible signal to stop by a police officer who was in uniform

5 the police officer.

7 **COUNT 4 RECKLESS DRIVING**

8 The defendant, on or about July 3, 2023, in Jackson County, Oregon, did unlawfully and
9 recklessly drive a vehicle upon a highway or premises open to the public in a manner
10 that endangered the safety of persons or property.
