

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, will consider the following Ordinance for Second Reading (Proposed Adoption) at a meeting and public hearing to be held at 5:05 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on September 22, 2026 at City Hall, 1300 White Street. The hearing for this item may be continued to a date certain as required by the City Commission.

An Ordinance of the City of Key West, Florida, adopting an Ad Valorem Tax General Municipal Millage Rate for FY 2026-2027; Providing for severability; Providing for repeal of inconsistent provisions; Providing for an effective date. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA: That the final adopted ad valorem tax general municipal millage rate for FY 2026-2027 is hereby set at 1.8848 mills (\$1.8848 per thousand dollars of assessed property value). The 2026-2027 final adopted millage rate is equal to the rolled back rate of 1.8848 mills (\$1.8848 per thousand dollars of assessed property value).
