

Annual EEO Public File Report

During this two day event they participated on panels about careers in journalism, long-form storytelling and sports production. The also spoke individually with students about positions within the Companies both current and in the future as well as internship opportunities at KHQ-TV, KNDO/U-TV and our Cowles Montana Stations. KHQ TV hired one intern to a full time position during this reporting period.

Events Sponsored by Educational Institutions related to Career Opportunities in Broadcasting

KHQ Employees participated in the Eastern Washington University Diversity & Inclusion Festival on April 18, 2024. The Director of Recruitment(DOR) and station representatives spoke with students from diverse cultures backgrounds about careers in broadcasting, media and content. We also talked about internships and job shadow opportunities across all our stations in Washington and Montana.

Events Sponsored by Educational Institutions related to Career Opportunities in Broadcasting

The Director of Recruitment (DOR) participated in three events that included classroom presentations where they spoke to grade schools or high school students about internships and job opportunities in a broadcast television station and the education necessary for the different positions.

KHQ sponsored a Junior Journalist Experience KHQ sponsored a Junior Journalist Experience contest which involved 13-18 year olds writing essays to learn and experience the broadcast journalism field. The 14 year old winner experienced traveling to the Johnson Space Center in Houston, TX, meeting and interviewing Spokane native and astronaut, Anne McClain, learned and worked with KHQ journalists (an Anchor and photographer). The interview appeared on air and streamed on NonStop Local KHQ. The Junior Journalist Experience is part of KHQ TV's extensive effort to offer opportunities to students to learn and experience the broadcast journalism field.

Training

KHQ Employees participated in a Cowles Corporate sponsored Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Series on 10/6/24 focused on Hispanic Heritage. Employees participated on a panel discussion and remaining employees learned virtually via Teams about Latin American history and understanding of Hispanic Latino Americans in our community and how to take action beyond to implement that understanding on a daily basis.

Training

The Station hires local college students and recent college graduates as freelance workers for live, over-the-air sports productions. With this, the station offers training to achieve the skill level necessary to successfully work in full time positions in the broadcast industry such as a field camera operator and production assistant. This experience led to freelance jobs with other network affiliated sports production companies such as ESPN and other larger sports networks.

The KHQ Station Manager attended the NAB conference in Las Vegas for 5 days of seminars and networking events in April 2024. The conference covered topics like best practices in hiring, management training, technology advancements to better the workforce, diversity in the workplace, and overcoming challenges in the present environment.

Seven Senior Broadcast Directors of KHQ participated in a six week Everything DISC-Work of Leaders training. The training provided a three-step process to reflect on how the leader might approach creating a vison, building alignment around the vision and championing execution of the vision. It focused on tangible steps directed at leading a group/organization toward desired outcomes using preferred behavior and best practices.

Training The KHQ Sales team meets weekly to use Google's Skillshop Academy learning Fundamentals of Digital Marketing to

advance their digital marketing skills. They are using business simulation exercises from Stukent, Novella and Stratix to

supplement this training. They utilize case studies through the Harvard Business Review for real life situational learning.

Training The KHQ managers have access to a "Manager Corner" a dedicated section on the Employee Resources online site

tailored to the management team providing valuable resources, guides, and tools to assist in day-today management tasks. Topics include, Effective interviewing techniques, interviewing do's and don'ts, Interviews-What Not to Ask and includes an Interview Question Bank. Interviewing and the ADA training module. Documentation Training as a Manager

and Company Practices and Standards, Performance Evaluation Training and various others.

Training All Cowles Company Stations Management Team participated in an all day Human Resources(HR) retreat on February

27, 2024. Rebecca Larson, a Senior Training Specialist and Organizational Development from Gonzaga University led the group in team building activities and spoke on the "Leader as a Coach" providing input into "Coaching" employees to reach their full potentials for employee development and performance. Discussion centered on generations in the workforce and how to manage each of them. Jessi Everhardt, of Cowles HR, also led sessions on interviewing and

performance reviews.

Training Cowles Company, owner of KHQ TV also provides a quarterly solutions newsletter resource for managers aimed at

bolstering leadership and human resource practices. Highlight examples include strategies for building meaningful relationships with team members from the get-go; Tips on supporting employees through personal challenges, including making the most of the EAP's counseling and support services and guidance on managing performance issues with

empathy and effectiveness.
