

Dear Woodland Families,

The high rate of staff absences has reached the point where we need to temporarily switch to remote learning for all Woodland students beginning tomorrow, Friday, and continuing through Monday. We are prepared to continue with remote learning after Monday if our staffing challenges persist. We are continuously evaluating this situation and will let you know on Monday the plan for Tuesday and beyond.

Today at Woodland we have 19 staff members out. Due to the District-wide shortage of substitute teachers, we only have three subs in classrooms here today. This makes it extremely difficult to continue in-person instruction and provide adequate student supervision throughout the school day. Our teachers and staff have done an amazing job of covering for their colleagues, and we have additional help today from District Office staff. We are getting by, but we expect this situation will not improve in the next few days. Across the district we have 110 absences in our instructional staff today, with nowhere near enough subs available to cover this.

**TODAY:** At the end of 7th period, students will have time to gather their Chromebooks and chargers, as well as any books, printed materials, medications, and other items they will need during this remote learning period.

**FRIDAY:** Teachers and students will transition to remote learning; we consider this a learning day. We expect students to log into their Schoology accounts and check all of their classes. Teachers will communicate with their students through Schoology on class expectations.

**MONDAY:** Students will participate from home according to their normal class schedule (starting at 9 a.m. for late-start Monday). We refer to this as synchronous learning, meaning that students are expected to virtually attend each period at the same time as their teacher and classmates. If remote learning continues on Tuesday, students will log on and be ready for their first class at 8 a.m. If teachers are too ill to provide synchronous learning, students will still have independent learning provided to them on Schoology.

Using Google Meet, teachers will host a video class meeting for at least 15 minutes at the start of the class period. This time will be used to take virtual attendance, connect with students, provide a mini-lesson, assist students in navigating Schoology, and answer students' questions. For the rest of the class period, students will work independently on assignments or activities.

**EXTRACURRICULAR:** 7th Grade Basketball parents, please watch your email for updates on practice and games.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Secondary bus routes that serve both Woodland and Lake City High School will still run for LCHS students.

**MEALS:** Grab-and-go lunches will be available at Woodland on these remote learning days – Friday and Monday. Families may pick up lunches between 11:15 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. inside the front entrance near the office.
