The State of Montana, by and through the Cascade County Attorney, pursuant to M.C.A. §§ 46-11-101(1), 46-11-401(1), 46-1-202(6), and 46-11-401(3), hereby files this complaint against the above-named Defendant in the above-captioned Justice Court for purposes of M.C.A. § 46-10-105(1), pending filing of an Information and Affidavit in District Court pursuant to M.C.A. §§ 46-11-101(3), 46-11-201, and 46-11-203. This complaint consists of this pleading and the attached law enforcement citation form(s) and probable cause affidavit(s) which by this reference are hereby incorporated herein as if set forth in their entirety.

A person convicted of the offense of indecent exposure to a minor shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$50,000 or be imprisoned in the state prison for a term of not less than 4 years, unless the judge makes a written finding that there is good cause to impose a term of less than 4 years and imposes a term of less than 4 years, or more than 100 years, or both.

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT

As outlined in the attached probable cause affidavit, on Wednesday, August 25th, 2021 at 1841 hours, GFPD Officer Lee was dispatched to the GFPD lobby to take a report regarding a Linda Bigbeaver attempted to fight the caller Belinda Hayes, and exposing herself in front of kids.

Upon arrival Officer Lee spoke with the caller Belinda, her husband I.H, and daughter B.H (juvenile 15yo). Officer Lee learned that near the area of 15th St and 8th Ave N around 1740 hours, Linda had observed Belinda, approached her and began trying to fight with Belinda using "odd" gestures and threatening language while the caller was waiting for her son to finish a fitness class at that location.

Belinda added that she got into her vehicle to get away from Linda as she approached her. Belinda yelled at Linda to go away and that there were kids were in the area. Belinda got her phone out and told Linda she was calling the cops. In response, Linda ran across the street to the corner and began to expose her breasts to Belinda and Belinda's juvenile daughter. Belinda has known Linda for their whole lives so she knew it was Linda who did these things.

Belinda's husband Isiah said he walked out with his juvenile son, and happened to look over at Linda on the street corner and observed Linda repeatedly pulling her shirt down to expose herself to them. Isiah added he also saw her buttocks as her pants were down around her knees and she was turning around showing "everything off".

Belinda's daughter said that she watched the whole incident between her mom and Linda and said that she also observed Linda "flashing" herself.

After Linda finally left, Belinda spoke with another parent who observed the incident and provided the name to Officer Lee. Officer Lee made contact with the witness (Katrina Bava) who said that she observed the female (Linda) acting very odd and yelling at Belinda. Katrina said she yelled for both of them to calm down as the kids were coming out of the fitness class. As Katrina noticed the kids coming from the class, she saw Linda pulling what she said was a white tank-top down exposing her breasts to the public. Katrina is a third party and does not know either party.

This incident took place in the presence of a youth event, and in front of at least two juveniles. Bigbeaver knowingly or purposely exposed her genitals or intimate parts by any means under circumstances in which she knew the conduct was likely to cause affront or alarm in order to abuse, humiliate, harass, or degrade another. At least one of those she exposed herself to was a minor.

Bigbeaver has an extensive misdemeanor history.

For the foregoing reasons, the State respectfully requests bond in the amount of \$1,500.
