Mike Kelly Declares Candidacy for State Senate Seat, Offering a Fiscally Conservative Choice

Spokane Valley, WA – Candidate and businessman Mike Kelly has filed with the Washington Secretary of State's office for the open Senate seat in District 4. Voters will be able to cast their votes for Kelly in the upcoming primary taking place on August 6th.

"I've talked to many citizens and business owners in District 4, and they share the same concerns that I have: increasing crime, homelessness, property taxes, and living costs, along with burdensome business regulations," says Kelly.
