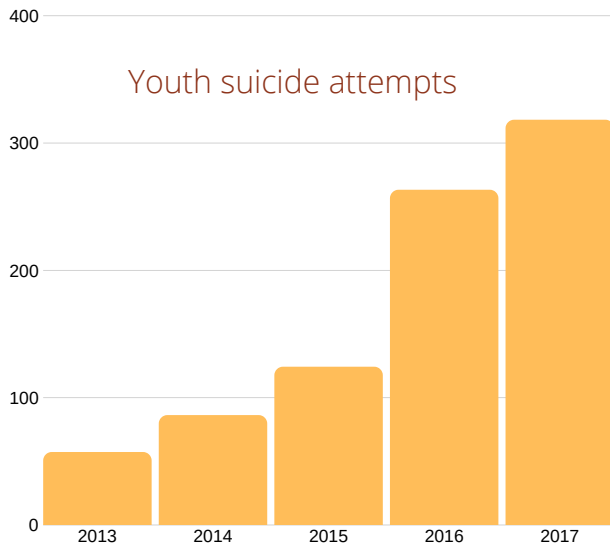


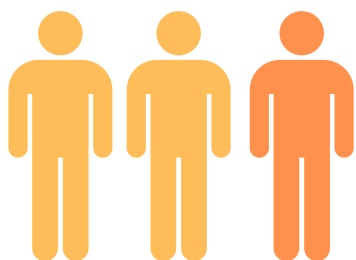

SPOKANE COUNTY AT A GLANCE



During 2016 in Spokane County, there were a combined 263 suicides and suicide attempts by adolescents aged 10-17, increasing from 48, or by **448%**, since 2000.



One in three youth ages 10-17 reported depression.



Substance use remains a concern; opioid-related deaths increased from 10 deaths in 1995 to 84 in 2016—a **740%** increase.

Spokane has a higher death rate than the state of Washington.



Spokane girls reported seriously considering suicide at almost twice the rate of boys.



Heroin was the predominant substance involved in opioid overdoses that required emergency response in 2016.



Overall, 23.2% of youth reported witnessing adult violence.



One in five youth reported physical abuse by an adult.



Total charges during 2012-2016 for inpatient hospitalizations among Spokane County residents was \$15.8 million.
