

Office of the Governor Press Conference: International Travel Restrictions

Beginning November 8:

- Vaccination and/or testing requirements for *all international travelers* entering the U.S.
- Hawai'i aligns with federal requirements for *direct* international passengers
 - ➡ Safe Travels Hawai'i continues for all domestic travelers and domestic flights

Direct International Travel to Hawai'i


Beginning Nov. 8 travelers must show prior to boarding their flight:

- Non-U.S. citizens:
 - proof of vaccination **AND**
 - negative COVID-19 NAAT or Antigen test within 3 days
- U.S. citizens:
 - proof of vaccination **OR**
 - negative COVID-19 NAAT or Antigen test within 1 day

Non-Direct International + Domestic Travel to Hawai'i

Beginning Nov. 8:

- International passengers entering U.S. via other U.S. airports will be treated as domestic travelers
- Safe Travels program remains in place for all domestic travelers
