

- You must pay the Internet Crimes Against Children fee in the amount of \$100.00.
- You must provide buccal swab samples and print or hand impressions as required by the collecting agency's rules and regulations, and/or provide blood specimens as required by the collecting agency's rules and regulations for law enforcement identification analysis.
- You must pay a monetary assessment of \$500.00 or the actual cost of DNA analysis, whichever is less to the DNA registry special fund.
- You must pay the Crime Victim Compensation fee/Internet Crimes Against Children fee/DNA assessment at the rate of 25% of gross earnings while incarcerated and \$30.00 per month thereafter.
