Diagnosis

First: Blunt force trauma

Trauma to the vaginal cavity. Grossly the vulva was significantly swollen and dilated 1.5 inches. Another male cat is not likely to cause this kind of trauma. The uterine swab showed blood tinged fluid that was positive for vaginal mucosal cells on cytology. The patient has not urinated and has an enlarged bladder. No evidence of urinary infection.
