INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1
Conspiracy to Distribute Methamphetamine
(21 U.S.C. § 846)

From a precise date unknown, but by at least 2013 and continuing to on or about June 22, 2016, within the District of Hawaii, BLAZE RYAN IKAIKA SOARES, LAMAR LAWRENCE AUWAE DEREBO, and REINALD YAMADA, the defendants, and M.P., not charged herein, did knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire and confederate with each other, and with others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A).

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

Count 2
Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine
(21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A))

On or about May 3, 2016, in the District of Hawaii, LAMAR LAWRENCE AUWAE DEREBO, and BLAZE RYAN IKAIKA SOARES, the defendants, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Forfeiture Notice

1. The allegations contained in all paragraphs of Counts 1 and 2 of this Indictment are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of noticing forfeiture pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.

2. The United States hereby gives notice to BLAZE RYAN IKAIKA SOARES, LAMAR LAWRENCE AUWAE DEREGO, and REINALD YAMADA, the defendants, that upon conviction of any of the offenses charged in Counts 1 and 2 of this Indictment, the government will seek forfeiture, in accordance with Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(a), of any and all property constituting, or derived from, any proceeds obtained, directly or indirectly, as the result of such offense, and any and all property used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of, the offense, including, but not limited to, approximately \$103,700.27 seized from a residence in Waimanalo, Hawaii, on or about May 3, 2016.

3. If any of the property described in paragraph 2 above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendants:

a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;

b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;

c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;

d. has been substantially diminished in value; or

e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property up

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to the value of the property described above in paragraph 2, pursuant to Title 21,
United States Code, Section 853(p).
