Page County Attorney, James L. Varley, reports the following activities in the Iowa District Court for Page County for the week of May 11, 2026. The Honorable Ashley West-Joons, District Associate Judge of the Fourth Judicial District presided. All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

Lorenzo Davila, age 37, Shenandoah, Iowa, appeared by counsel and admitted to violating the terms and conditions of probation. Defendant was given 2 days contempt time to be served at the Page County Jail and was ordered to continue on probation as previously sentenced.

Adam Wayne Morris, age 48, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared by counsel and pled guilty to Sex Offender Registration Violation- First Offense. The defendant was sentenced to 2 years in prison, suspended, and placed on probation for 2 years. Defendant was ordered to pay a fine of \$855, court costs, surcharges and court-appointed attorney fees.

Samuel Wade Walker, age 51, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared by counsel and pled guilty to Operating While Under the Influence-2nd Offense. The defendant was ordered to serve 45 days in jail, with all but 7 days suspended. Defendant was fined \$1,875 and placed on probation for 1 year. As a condition of probation, the defendant is to obtain a substance abuse evaluation and complete the 12-hour Drinking Driver's Course.

Samuel Wade Walker, age 51, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared by counsel and admitted to violating the terms and conditions of probation. Defendant's probation was revoked and the original sentence was imposed. Defendant was ordered to serve 100 days in the Page County Jail, receiving credit for any time already served, including 29 days of "good time". This sentence is to run concurrent with the case above.
