

Public Notice

The Page County Temporary Redistricting Commission will hold a public hearing on Monday, August 25, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. in the Page Room at the Page County Courthouse. The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public a description of the proposed redistricting plan, changing the districts of the Page County Board of Supervisors from 3 districts to 5 districts. Members of the public are encouraged to submit comments and/or attend the public meeting, ask questions, and present alternative plans. The proposed districts are as follows:

District 1: In Shenandoah, starting at the corner of US Highway 59 and W. Valley Ave, Follow W. Valley East to N. Center St. Follow N. Center St/S. Center St South to US Highway 2. Follow US Highway 2 West to US Highway 59. Follow US Highway 59 North to W. Valley Ave. Except Census Blocks 2005, 3049, 3050, 3051. Also included is the entirety of Census Block 1050.

District 2: Contains all of Pierce and Grant Townships and the City of Shenandoah except those parts which are in District 1.

District 3: Contains all of Fremont, Tarkio, Morton, Washington, Lincoln, Colfax, Harlan, Amity, East River, and Buchanan Townships. Nodaway Township West of Redwood Ave and the City of Clarinda except those parts which are in District 4.

District 4: In Clarinda, starting at corner of N 17th St and W. Walnut St, follow W. Walnut/E. Walnut St East to N. 15th St. Follow N. 15th/S.15th St South to E. Garfield St. Follow E. Garfield St East to S. 12th St. Follow S. 12th St South to US Highway 2. Follow US Highway 2 West to Business US Highway 2. Follow Business US Highway 2 East to the West Boundary of Census Block 2013. District 4 will also include Census Blocks 2011, 2012, 2013, 2023, 2024, and 2035.

District 5: Contains all of Douglas, Valley, and Nebraska Townships. District 5 will also include Nodaway Township East of Redwood Ave and the City of Clarinda except those parts which are in Districts 3 and 4.

A map of the proposed districts, a summary of the standards prescribed by law for the development of redistricting plans, and the population and relative deviation of each district population from the ideal district population, may be obtained at the Page County Auditor's Office or on the Page County website, pagecounty.iowa.gov. Comments or objections may also be sent to the Page County Auditor's Office, 112 E Main St, Clarinda, IA 51632.

After this public hearing, the temporary redistricting commission shall adopt a supervisor district plan and corresponding precinct plan, if applicable, and shall submit the plan to the board of supervisors for their approval.
