**Page County Attorney, Carl M. Sonksen, reports the following activities in the Iowa District Court for Page County for the week of January 6, 2020. The Honorable Michael Hooper, District Court Judge of the Fourth Judicial District presided. All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.**

William Joseph Bullock, age 37, Omaha, Nebraska appeared with his attorney and admitted to violating the terms and conditions of his probation. The Defendant's probation was revoked and the original sentence entered June 8, 2018 was imposed. The Defendant is committed to prison for a term not to exceed two years. The Defendant was ordered to pay court costs, court-appointed attorney fees and surcharges.

Leonard Leroy Good, age 70, Shenandoah, Iowa appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Burglary in the Third Degree. The Defendant was granted a deferred judgment and was placed on probation for two years. The Defendant was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000, suspended, as well as court costs, court-appointed attorney fees and surcharges.

Devin Wallace, age 27, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared with his attorney and admitted to violating the terms and conditions of his deferred judgment. The Defendant pled guilty to Manufacture, Deliver or Possess with the Intent to Manufacture or Deliver Marijuana. The Defendant was sentenced to prison for a term not to exceed five years and fined \$750, suspended. The Defendant was ordered to pay court costs, court-appointed attorney fees and surcharges.

Devin Wallace, age 27, Clarinda, Iowa appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Possession of Methamphetamine With Intent to Deliver. The Defendant was sentenced to prison for a period not to exceed 10 years to run concurrent with the previous charge. The Defendant is fined \$1,000, suspended and ordered to pay court costs, court-appointed attorney fees and surcharges.
