Page County Attorney, Carl M. Sonksen, reports the following activities in the Iowa District Court for Page County for the week of July 12, 2021. The Honorable Margaret Reyes, District Court Judge of the Fourth Judicial District presided. All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

Austin Debolt, age 28, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Operating While Intoxicated, 2nd Offense. The Defendant was sentenced to 120 days in the county jail with all but 7 days suspended. Defendant was placed on probation for two years, ordered to obtain a substance abuse evaluation and successfully complete the Drinking Driver's School. The Defendant was ordered to pay a fine of \$1,875.00, plus surcharges, court costs and court-appointed attorney fees.

Isaiah Carpenter, age 18, Shenandoah, Iowa, appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance- Marijuana, 1st Offense. Judgment was deferred for one year, during which he was placed on probation. Defendant is to obtain a substance abuse evaluation. Defendant was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$430.00, plus surcharges, courtappointed attorney fees and court costs.

Cassandra Gibson, age 30, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared with her attorney and pled guilty to Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated, Frist Offense. The Defendant was sentenced to 30 days in jail, with all but 2 days suspended. Defendant was placed on probation for one year and ordered to obtain a substance abuse evaluation, as well as, authorized to enter the Second Chances Program to satisfy 48 hours of incarceration. The Defendant was ordered to pay fines, court costs and surcharges.

Robert Harvey, age 58, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Driving While Barred. The Defendant was sentenced to 20 days in the Page County Jail, with credit for time served. The Defendant was ordered to pay court costs, court-appointed attorney fees, surcharges and a fine of \$855.00.

Paige Vincent, age 31, Clarinda, Iowa, appeared with her attorney and pled guilty to Tampering With Records. Judgment was deferred for one year, during which she was placed on probation. Defendant was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750, which was suspended, plus surcharges, court-appointed attorney fees, court costs and restitution.
