Page County Attorney, Carl M. Sonksen, reports the following activities in the Iowa District Court for Page County for the weeks of June 7, 2021. The Honorable James S. Heckerman, District Court Judge of the Fourth Judicial District presided. All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

Jacob Allen Cochran, age 39, Council Bluffs, Iowa, appeared with his attorney and admitted to violating the terms of his probation. The Defendant probation was revoked and his original sentenced of five years in prison was imposed.

Summer Brooke French, age 25, Shenandoah, Iowa, appeared with her attorney and admitted to violating the terms of her probation. The Defendant's probation was revoked and she was found in willful contempt of court. Defendant was sentenced to 30 days in jail.

Donald Alan Howk, age 48, Clarinda, Iowa appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Criminal Mischief in the 2nd Degree. The Defendant was sentenced to 293 days in jail and given credit for time served. The Defendant was ordered to pay \$2,000 restitution, court costs, expenses and surcharges.

Preston Scott Runyon, age 19, Clarinda, Iowa with his attorney and pled guilty to Assault Causing Bodily Injury. Sentence was deferred for 1 year and defendant was placed on probation for 1 year. The Defendant was ordered to pay court costs, expenses and surcharges.

Edward Paul Swanson, age 60, Braddyville, Iowa appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Possession of Methamphetamine, Second Offense. The Defendant was sentenced to 5 days in jail. Defendant was ordered to pay a \$855 fine, plus court costs, expenses and surcharges.

Edward Paul Swanson, age 60, Braddyville, Iowa appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Operating While Intoxicated, First Offense. The Defendant was sentenced to 5 days in jail. Defendant was ordered to pay a \$1,250 fine, plus court costs, expenses and surcharges.

James Lee Stouder, Jr., age 41, Shenandoah, Iowa, appeared with his attorney and pled guilty to Theft in the Fourth Degree. The Defendant was sentenced to 30 days in jail, suspended and placed on probation for 1 year. The Defendant was also ordered to pay court costs, expenses and surcharges.

Rosalina Welch, age 53, Maryville, Missouri, appeared with her attorney and pled guilty to Tampering With Records. Judgment and sentence were deferred. Defendant was placed on

probation for 1 year. The Defendant was ordered to pay victim restitution in the amount of \$24,251.51, \$855 civil penalty, court costs, and surcharges.
