NARRATIVE:

On 06/11/2025 Deputies with the Adams County Sheriffs Office arrested 28-year-old Ward, Kenton Ray of Missouri for Possession of Controlled Substance Marijuana (148 grams) and Possession of Paraphernalia following a traffic stop at Highway 25 and 265th Street. Ward was transported to the Adams County Jail where he was booked.

NARRATIVE:

On 6/6/2025, Deputies with the Adams County Sheriff's office conducted a traffic stop on a 2022 Ford F350 for speeding. Upon contact with the driver, the deputy observed an odor of marijuana. The deputy conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle, and the driver was placed under arrest for Possession of a controlled substance – marijuana 2nd offense. After arriving at the Adams County Jail, the driver admitted to having a folded dollar bill in her wallet. The bill had a crystalline white substance that field tested positive for methamphetamines.

Renessa Renee Salinas, 32 of Waterloo, was booked into the Adams County Jail on the charges of Possession of a controlled substance – marijuana 2nd offense, and possession of a controlled substance – 2nd offense (w 1 non-marijuana). Additionally, Salinas was cited for Speed, driving under suspension, and operating without SR-22 insurance.
