Page County Attorney, Carl M. Sonksen, reports the following activities in the Iowa District Court for Page County for the week of February 3, 2025. The Honorable Margaret Reyes, District Court Judge of the Fourth Judicial District presided. All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

Corey Burton Dugger, age 40, Onawa, Iowa, appeared by counsel and admitted violating the terms and conditions of probation. The Defendant was found to be in willful contempt of court and sentenced to 21 days in the Page County Jail, with credit given for time previously served.

This sentence will run concurrent to the case above.

David Jacob Stimson, age 64, Shambaugh, Iowa, appeared with counsel and admitted violating the terms and conditions of probation. The Defendant was found to be in willful contempt of court and sentenced to 87 days in the Page County Jail. Defendant was given credit for time previously served in connection with this case.

Megan Renee Sunderman, age 39, Omaha, Nebraska, appeared with counsel and pled guilty to Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, Methamphetamine. The Defendant was granted a deferred judgment and placed on probation for three years. As a condition of probation, the Defendant is to obtain a drug/alcohol evaluation and is to follow through with any recommendations. Defendant was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,360, plus surcharges, court costs and court-appointed attorney fees.
