

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Officer Ryan Berry, knowing that **false statements on this form are punishable by law**, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 12/09/2024(offense date) at E 32nd St & S Lewellen Ave (offense location), Grosso, Breshia R, (suspect name) a white Female (suspect description) committed one or more criminal offense(s) of : Assault 1st degree 565.050, Tampering 1st degree 569.080, Property Damage 1st Degree 569.100, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia 579.074. (State name of offense and statute number)

Arrested: 12/09/2024, 05:18; In Custody (Arrest date and time or NOT IN CUSTODY)

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 12/09/2024 at approximately 05:06 hours, in the County of Jasper Missouri, within the city limits of Joplin, Breshia Grosso committed the crimes of Assault 1st Degree by knowingly causing series injury to another, Tampering 1st degree by being in possession of a stolen motor vehicle, Property Damage 1st degree by knowingly causing damage to another vehicle with an approximate value of \$20,000, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia by being in possession of equipment known to be used to consume narcotics.

Ms. Grosso was traveling on E 32nd St, when she knowingly struck the rear of a Mercedes Sprinter van. Ms. Grosso knowingly struck the rear of the Sprinter van several times causing extensive damage to the vehicle. Ms. Grosso then struck the driver of the Sprinter van, pinning him between the vehicle she was driving and the Sprinter van. Ms. Grosso's actions caused serious physical injury to the driver. Ms. Grosso then left the scene, being located at Quik Trip on E 32nd Street. It was discovered Ms. Grosso was in possession of a stolen vehicle that had been previously reported stolen approximately forty-five minutes earlier within the city of Joplin Missouri. Ms. Grosso was found to be in possession of a glass pipe with a black residue inside and a hypodermic needle commonly known to consume narcotics.

V1 the driver of the Sprinter van stated he was traveling east bound on E 32nd Street when he was struck by another vehicle. V1 stated the vehicle struck the back of his van several times before he exited to see what had happened. V1 stated the vehicle then struck him pinning V1 between his van and the other vehicle. V1 left knee was swollen and it appeared he had wounds to his left foot.

W2 stated he was leaving CFI, when observed a white single cab Chevrolet truck strike the rear of the Sprinter van. W2 stated he observed the truck ram the van several times. W2 stated the driver of the van walked to the back of it and was struck by the truck, pinning him between the van and truck. W2 stated the truck then left the area east bound on E 32nd Street.

W1 stated she was also leaving CFI when she observed the incident. W1 stated she observed the truck strike the rear of the van several times, before striking the driver and pinning him between both vehicles. W1 provided a Missouri registration number of 6AGV30. That matched the registration number on the truck Ms. Grosso was operating at time of contact.

I have no further to add at this time.
