The suspect placed her [REDACTED] in substantial risk of loss of life by setting a fire that fully engulfed the apartment complex the two were residing in,

then abandoning the [REDACTED] with a bucket of full "one hitter" alcohol bottles and drug paraphernalia.

After locating the suspect and taking her into custody, the suspect admitted to the State Fire Marshall that she set the fire.

The suspect woke the [REDACTED] up, took [REDACTED] outside the residence, then the suspect ran off into the nearby woods, leaving the [REDACTED] behind, unable to keep up with her. The suspect took the [REDACTED] outside without substantial clothing for the elements and cold, also with no shoes.

The [REDACTED] was seen in the parking lot of another nearby apartment building ([REDACTED]), and yelling and crying hysterically for [REDACTED] and was taken in by an [REDACTED], who tried to calm the [REDACTED]

The suspect, after fleeing the structure fire that displaced 32 individuals and 19 families, ran to a nearby neighborhood, where she forced entry into the lower level of an occupied duplex, ([REDACTED]) through the basement sliding glass door. The suspect was confronted by the home owner, who demanded she leave. After telling the suspect two times to get out, the suspect fled the residence through the same entry point and was last seen running in a southerly direction through the residential neighborhood on [REDACTED]

Action requested:

I am requesting a summons be issued.

I am requesting a warrant for the following reason(s):

The defendant is a danger to the public: Because the suspect admitted to setting fire to an apartment complex, then fleeing the scene. The suspect placed many victims lives in danger, as well as Fire and Law Enforcement personnel, who had to evacuate the fully engulfed structure.

The defendant is a danger to the crime victim:

The defendant is a flight risk: because she fled the scene of a structure fire that she admitted to setting and that displaced 19 families and 32 individuals. I fear if she is released from custody, she will flee the area. The suspect demonstrated she has no regard to the safety of her own [REDACTED] as well as the lives of numerous other residents of the apartment complex.
