

8. REPORTING/DIRECTIVES: I will report as directed to my Probation and Parole Officer. I agree to abide by any directives given to me by my Probation and Parole Officer.

9. SUPERVISION STRATEGY: I will enter and successfully complete any supervision strategy and abide by all rules and programs requirements, as directed by the Court, Board, or my supervising Probation and Parole Officer.

10. INTERVENTION FEE: I shall pay a monthly intervention fee in the amount set by Missouri Department of Corrections pursuant to RSMo 217.690. This payment shall be due and payable on the first day of the first month following placement of probation, parole or conditional release.

11. SPECIAL CONDITIONS: Defendant to not have unsupervised contact with any children

Defendant has violated the following conditions of probation: 1 and 11


#1, LAWS, by committed statutory sodomy in the first degree and child molestation in the first degree on or about March 19, 2026, as charged on March 28, 2026.

#11, SPECIAL CONDITIONS, by having unsupervised contact with a child on or about March 19, 2026.

WHEREFORE, the State of Missouri moves this Court to suspend the probation granted in this case, to issue a *capias* warrant for defendant **with no bond**, and to set a hearing at the earliest convenience of the Court on this motion.
