I, MSgt. B. Corum, #1302, knowing that **false statements on this form are punishable by law**, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 09/09/2025(offense date) at 2580 High Street, Sarcxie, MO 64862 (offense location), Jayson Matthew Maloney, (suspect name) a white male, (suspect description) committed one or more criminal offense(s) of : Valentine's Law (RsMO 575.151), Littering (RsMO 577.070), Operating a vehicle in a careless and imprudent manner (RsMO 304.012), and Tampering with a motor vehicle (RsMO 569.080) . (State name of offense and statute number)

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

I, MSgt. Corum went to Love's Travel Stop to get fuel at the end of my shift. I observed a white passenger vehicle parked at a gas pump bearing MO LP XE7N4R. I ran the license plate, and it came back to a stolen vehicle.

I observed the vehicle get onto High Street going northbound. I initiated my emergency lights and siren as the vehicle turned right onto the eastbound I-44 on-ramp. I caught up to the vehicle between the 31 and 32 mile markers. I advised JASCO of our location, and the vehicle was coming back as stolen. The white Mazda pulled off on the shoulder to stop. As I was getting ready to put my vehicle in Park and exit, the vehicle accelerated and fled the traffic stop. I advised JASCO that the vehicle was fleeing eastbound on I-44 from our location. I went to activate my body camera, I did not have it, remembering I placed it on the dock due to it being end of shift.

Traffic was light and we were going speeds of 110 mph. Starting around mile marker 40, the driver began to throw items from his vehicle. The items varied from plastic bags, clothing, and a large glass object. At mile marker 50.8, our speeds reduced to 90 mph. Between mile markers 60 and 64, speeds increased to 112 mph, then to 120 mph. The Lawrence County Sheriff's Office set up spikes around the 68-mile marker; however, the driver was able to miss them. The Springfield Police Department had spikes deployed at the 75.6-mile marker. Throughout the pursuit, the driver would brake-check me, slow the vehicle down for semi-trucks, and other vehicles before exiting eastbound I-44 before the 75.6-mile marker. I observed the vehicle start to lose control. As it was exiting, I could see the

front right tire had blown. We exited onto West Bypass, then headed east on Kearney. From Kearney, I was able to relay that we had gotten onto Cresthaven.

Once Greene County was able to join in, I let them take the lead. We then went northbound on Fulbright, made a loop through a trailer park, and back out on Fulbright heading southbound to Kearney. We went southbound on Roosevelt to Atlantic to the south. We went southbound on Park, then westbound on Thoman. At Thoman and Kansas Expressway, we went northbound in the wrong lane of traffic to westbound Atlantic. We then went northbound on Clifton, the eastbound on High Street. At Farmer and High Street, Greene County was able to stop the vehicle by blocking it in. They were able to get the driver out without further incident.
