JOURNAL ENTRY—MISDEMEANOR/TRAFFIC CASE

On the date and time of electronic filing hereof, the above-entitled matter comes on before the court for TRIAL or PLEA.

The defendant, Warren Jungles appears in person pro se and by and through attorney Amy Ross. The State of Kansas appears by and through Alan Brereton, Deputy Labette County Attorney.

The State moves to amend the complaint: COUNT 1: Interference with law enforcement, a class A nonperson misdemeanor in violation of K.S.A. 21-5904(a)(1)(C).

The defendant announces he pleads guilty nolo contendere to: COUNT 1: Interference with law enforcement, a class A nonperson misdemeanor in violation of K.S.A. 21-5904(a)(1)(C).

A trial is held and the defendant is found guilty of COUNT not guilty.

SENTENCING: On the date upon electronic filing, on a plea, verdict of guilty, the defendant is sentenced to confinement in the jail of Labette County, Kansas, for 6 months, suspended upon the payment of fine(s) and/or fulfillment of conditions as follows:

The defendant must obtain a mental health evaluation and follow all recommendations of the provider.

The defendant's CSO shall have the discretion to order a drug and alcohol evaluation with the requirement to follow all recommendations therefrom in the event there is an admission, refusal, or positive toxicology result from a drug screen examination done by the defendant in the ordinary course of supervision.

Remaining Counts Dismissed

All evidence currently being held by law enforcement is forfeited to said law enforcement agency for sale, use or destruction as required by law.

PROBATION: the defendant is placed on probation from this above ordered sentence for a period of 12 months supervised (by court services community corrections) unsupervised upon the condition that court costs (\$158.00) (\$108.00), BIDS application fee (\$100.00), probation fees (\$60.00), booking/fingerprint fee (\$45.00), laboratory fees to KBI (\$400) MSSU (\$150), ADSAP assessment fee of \$150.00 to Family Life Center, fine of \$ are paid within 12 months. Standard Conditions in addition to those listed above.
