That the facts supporting this belief are as follows:

1. On 04-22-2022 Nevada officers were dispatched to the report of a subject that entered a residence at [REDACTED] N. Clay St. and assaulted a juvenile.
2. On scene the [REDACTED] told us that an unknown white male (later identified as Jason Omar Clark) came in through the front door, [REDACTED] contact her mother and went to her room. [REDACTED] is that Jason followed her into her room, pushed her down on her bed by her throat and began stuffing something into her mouth.
3. [REDACTED] that Jason was saying sexual things to her and kissed her, then asked if anyone else was home to which she acknowledged yes. [REDACTED] told us that Jason looked around then left the residence.
4. While talking with [REDACTED] I could see dried blood around her mouth and inside I could see red marks from the object that was forced into her mouth. The item was identified as an aqua/blue terry cloth hair wrap.
5. On 04-25-2022 [REDACTED] was given a photo lineup with the suspect on spot #5. [REDACTED] looked at all of the picture's then pointed to #5 and stated "that's him". After [REDACTED] identified Jason, I could see that her legs began to shake and she lost the color in her face.

That the facts supporting this belief are as follows:

1. On 4/23/2022 I Sgt. Daniel Hayes responded to the area of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for a report of a male running through yards yelling that he was going to abduct children.
2. Searching the area several subjects began directing officers west of Austin Blvd.
3. I located a subject running frantically through yards at Hunter St and West St. The male was waving his arms above his head almost as if he was running from something.
4. I attempted to first make contact with the male walking in the yard of a house on West St. He began telling me that he was going to his brother's house and pointed toward Walnut St. The male ran from West St and went and laid in a back yard of [REDACTED]
5. Officers then made contact with the male and asked what was going on. The male did not make sense stating that this was his friend's house and that he was just trying to get some rec. time. I asked him if he knew his name and he could only tell me [REDACTED] and claimed he had amnesia from getting hit in the head. I asked him if he knew his last name and he claimed he thought he was a [REDACTED]
6. At this time we attempted to place him into custody to identify him and the male attempted to flee.
7. Officer Overstreet and I grabbed the male and took him to the ground. After several minutes of wrestling with the male and giving him commands to comply and give us his hands we had to forcefully pull his hands to the small of his back to place him into handcuffs.
8. After securing him into handcuffs he would yell that his name was Gator and that he was a king.
9. A search of his person found that he had a small hatchet concealed in his waist band.
10. After transporting him to the Vernon County Jail the male was identified as [REDACTED] and found that he had felony warrants out of Kansas.
11. Contact was made with the reporting party, [REDACTED]. He advised that he had seen Clark running around yards and the streets of [REDACTED]. The male was seen jumping into the neighbor's yard at [REDACTED] and then run off in erratic way.
12. Contact was made with the resident of [REDACTED]
13. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] were outside playing in a fenced in area and she was in the kitchen. She advised the two boys came in and began yelling that a man just came into the yard and tried to take them. When she went to look she saw [REDACTED] running west [REDACTED] and the neighbor [REDACTED] the phone with the police.
14. Speaking with the two boys, one boy advised that Clark had jumped into their yard and said "drop by take kids". The other boy advised only that he heard Clark say "drop by".

15. Contact was made with the resident of [REDACTED] She confirmed that she knew a Jason Clark, but stated she did not want him in her yard but did not wish to press charges at this time.
