I, Ofc Mosley, knowing that **false statements on this form are punishable by law**, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 03/17/2026(offense date) at 3517 N Red Iron Dr (offense location), Patrick Morgan, (suspect name) a white male, (suspect description) committed one or more criminal offense(s) of : Animal abuse RSMO 578.012. . (State name of offense and statute number)

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 03/17/2026 in the State of Missouri, in the County of Jasper, in the City of Webb City, I have reason to believe that Patrick Morgan committed the crime of Animal Abuse, when he intentionally, purposefully, and knowingly failed to provide adequate care to his dog Snoop (a male golden/brown medium size dog). Patrick failed to provide adequate care by dumping his dog in an industrial park located at 3517 N Red Iron Drive which resulted in the death of Snoop. It was also reported that Snoop was abused at his residence located in Joplin Missouri. Sydney Morgan advised that she had observed Snoop teathered to the door of the apartment. Sydney advised that the Snoop was wet and cold. Sydney also stated that their daughter (age 10) had observed Patrick fail to feed Snoop and strike him as punishment several times. Upon my arrival I was notified by Cintas staff that Snoop was dumped in a field to the north of their faculty. Staff advised that Snoop was malnourished and couldn't stand. Upon observing Snoop, Snoop appeared to be starving with his ribs, spine, skull, and legs having no meaty flesh on them. Snoop was drooling, slow to react to stimulus, and could not walk on his own accord. When picking Snoop up to put in my patrol vehicle my fingers could feel through the webbing of his rib cage and into his chest and abdominal cavity. I was provided video footage from Hannah Birkinsha showing Bianca and Patrick removing the dog from their apartment located in Joplin Missouri. The humane society indicated that Snoop had to be put on pain medicine due to the pain that he was in during their care. While in the Humane Society's care was pronounced deceased on March 19th of 2026.

3. MISDEMEANORS AND FELONIES: (If seeking a warrant) I am requesting issuance of an arrest warrant based on the following:

I believe that the defendant will not appear in court in response to a criminal summons because: Patrick has a history of not answering the door to law enforcement and not returning phone calls from law enforcement leading me to believe that they would not show up to court (State specific facts supporting your belief)

I believe that the defendant poses a danger to a crime victim / the community or to any other person because: Patrick Morgan failed to meet the adequate means of care for an animal under his care, custody, and control. (State specific facts supporting your belief)
