TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Upon reading the verified Petition in this action and the Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, and reviewing applicable case law, it appears to the Court that the Defendants have illegally connected their RV park and are dumping raw sewage into the City of Joplin sanitary sewer system without consent or permission. Furthermore, Defendants are reaping a commercial benefit from the use of such system without just compensation for services as set forth in Plaintiff's verified Petition, and unless restrained by order of this Court, and it further appearing that immediate and irreparable injury, loss and damage will result to Plaintiff's duty to protect the public health and welfare by preventing or abating the pollution of water and creating means for supplying wholesome water, and it further appearing that there is substantial cause to issue the Temporary Restraining Order without Notice, because of such facts:

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-named Defendants are hereby restrained from the unpermitted use of the City of Joplin sanitary sewer system; the Court further orders the above-named Defendants immediately disconnect the unpermitted RV park hook-ups from the City of Joplin sanitary sewer and cease the unpermitted dumping of sewage as described in

Plaintiff's verified petition; and that this Temporary Restraining Order shall remain in full force and effect until the preliminary injunction is heard or by 2024 ~~unless extended by further~~ order of this Court. *K*

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's injunction bond be waived in lieu of the damages for the previous sewer disconnection and repair caused by Defendants in the amount of \$5,383.53.
