

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Ofc. I. Allard (1066), knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 06/17/2024 (offense date), in Joplin, Jasper County, Missouri (offense location), (suspect name) Austin Dylan Wayne Bryant, a white male, (suspect description) committed one or more criminal offense(s) of: Assault in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree x2 (565.050), Robbery in the First Degree (570.023), and Armed Criminal Action x2 (571.015). (State name of offense and statute number)

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 6/17/24 Bryant was in Joplin, Jasper County, Missouri with Witness 1. Witness 1 contacted Victim 2 via Snapchat. Bryant set up a trade with Victim 2 to trade alcohol for marijuana. Victim 2 took Bryant and Witness 1 to Victim 1's house. After a brief period of relaxation, Victim 2 left Victim 1's house to get the marijuana to trade. Bryant and Witness 1 left the house while Victim 1 stayed inside.

Bryant told Witness 1 that he needed to use the restroom and went back inside. Witness 1 heard three gunshots and ran toward the house thinking Bryant had been shot. Witness 1 saw Bryant exiting Witness 1's house carrying a black compact pistol and a bag of marijuana. Witness 1 began to run and then heard Bryant yelling. Witness 1 looked back to see Victim 2 running across Victim 1's yard while Bryant shot him.

Victim 1 was shot once in the abdomen and once in the leg that traveled through both legs. Victim 2 was shot once in the abdomen. Prior to Witness 1 coming to the police station to give a statement, Bryant sent him a text saying he hid everything in the attic. A pistol matching the description of the one used to shoot Victim 1 and 2, and a bag of marijuana weighing 23.89g were found in Bryant's house during the execution of a search warrant. The pistol was found in the attic in a gray bag and the marijuana was in a bag in a box by the door. Additionally, we located the clothing the witnesses claimed Bryant was wearing in the living room of his house.
