



STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Officer Doug Dickey, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 09/11/2023 at a residence in Carl Junction, Jasper County, Missouri, **Corban Mitchell Radley**, a white male, committed one or more criminal offense(s) of :
 - a. 4th Degree Domestic Assault, RSMo 565.076, Class A Misdemeanor
 - b. Resisting Arrest, RSMo 575.150, Class E Felony, by fleeing in a vehicle and creating a substantial risk of serious physical injury or death to any person

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

At 2:06 pm, 09/19/2023, at a residence in Carl Junction, Jasper County, Missouri, the defendant, Corban Mitchell Radley, assaulted his wife, the victim, by aggressively confronting her in a manner that placed her in fear of her physical safety. During an argument with the defendant, the victim decided to leave the house for a while. She got into her car, but the defendant followed her, telling her she could leave but not with the car. As he became more agitated, the victim locked the doors. The defendant lay down behind the car to prevent the victim from leaving, then got up when he realized she was calling the police. He went to her car door, yelling at her and attempting repeatedly to open the door. This placed her in fear for her safety because she did not know what he would do if he got the door open. The victim said that she would assist in pursuing charges.

As police units were arriving on scene, the defendant, who had gotten into his own car, pulled out of the driveway and sped off, violating a stop sign. The two police units pursued briefly but terminated after observing the vehicle travelling at or near 100 mph on a county road with a 45 mph speed limit. They continued to track the car, locating it at County Road 290 & Kafir, where the defendant had lost control, violated another stop sign, and crashed into a wooded area and overturned. He suffered only minor injuries.

The defendant said that during their argument, he had attempted to prevent his wife from leaving, and had attempted to open her car doors, but denied that he would have assaulted her. He fled from the police because he didn't want to talk to them.
