THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

[18 U.S.C. §§ 1151, 1153, and 1111]

On or about November 9, 2018, within Indian Country in the Northern District of Oklahoma, the defendant, **SAMSON EUGENE FRYE, JR.**, an Indian, caused the unlawful killing of K.F. with malice aforethought, in that he perpetrated and attempted to perpetrate child abuse and, during the perpetration of the child abuse, K.F. was killed.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1151, 1153, and 1111.


COUNT TWO
[18 U.S.C. §§ 1151 and 1153; 21 O.S. § 843.5(C)]

Between on or about August 10, 2018 and continuing through November 9, 2018, within Indian Country in the Northern District of Oklahoma, the defendant, **SAMSON EUGENE FRYE, JR.**, an Indian responsible for the health, safety and welfare of K.F., a child under the age of 18 years known to the Grand Jury, willfully and maliciously failed and omitted to provide adequate nurturance and affection, food, clothing, shelter, sanitation, hygiene, or appropriate education, medical, dental, or behavioral health care, supervision or appropriate caretakers, or special care made necessary by the physical or mental condition of K.F.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1151 and 1153; Title 21, Oklahoma Statutes, Section 843.5(C).
