- 5.On 04-05-25 the victim contacted me, Deputy Jimmie Dye and advised me that the she was to meet with someone at Wal Mart at approximately 1430 to drop of the additional \$20,000.00.
- 6. The victim was advised by me to agree to meet the subjects but not to provide any money.
- 7. At approximately 1553 Bhagya Jigneshk Patel arrived in the Wal Mart parking lot and was attempting to make contact with the victim and was arrested.
- 8. In plane view setting in the back seat of Patel's car I found a cardboard box which contained \$37,000.00 in \$100 dollar bills.
- 9. During this time the victim received a phone call asking if the agent had received the money from her and she stated yes. The subject on the phone stated he would confirm with his agent and a short time later I observed a text message appear on the phone that had been in Patel's possession that stated "All Good ???".
