I, Reina Probert, the undersigned Crawford County Attorney, in the name and by the authority and on behalf of the State of Kansas, for Information against the above-named Defendant, **Bri'yon E Baker**, come now here and give to the Court to understand and be informed and do give the Court the following information:

COUNT 1. That on or about the 16th day of October, 2021, in Crawford County, Kansas, Bri'yon E Baker, then and there being present did unlawfully, feloniously and intentionally kill another human being, to wit: Jase E Delich. In violation of K.S.A. 21-5403, Murder in the Second Degree, a severity level 1 person felony.

COUNT 2. That on or about the 16th day of October, 2021, in Crawford County, Kansas, Bri'yon E Baker, then and there being present did unlawfully and feloniously obtain control over stolen property which is a firearm worth less than \$25,000.00, to-wit: Smith & Wesson 9mm handgun, knowing the property or services to have been stolen by another, with the intent to

permanently deprive the owner, to-wit: Enrique Selman, of the possession, use or benefit of such firearm. In violation of K.S.A. 21-5801(a)(4) & (b)(7), Possession of Stolen Property, a severity level 9 nonperson felony.
