VISITOR INFORMATION

- Non-COVID positive patients are allowed one visitor per day. Exceptions where patients are allowed 2 visitors per day include:
 - Nursery and Neonatal Intensive Care patients
 - Pediatric patients on inpatient units
 - Obstetrics
- Patients at the end of life will be allowed 2 visitors at a time. Up to 4 different people can take turns visiting each day, as long as no more than 2 visitors are in the hospital at the same time. Alternating visitors cannot wait in the facility.
- No visitors allowed under the age of 16.
- No visitors allowed for COVID positive patients.
- All visitors will be screened, including temperature checks, before entry.
- Visitors for inpatients must use the main entrance. If you are visiting a patient in the emergency department or outpatient services area and that patient becomes an inpatient between 7 AM and 7 PM, you will need to go to the main entrance to get a visitor badge.
- Visitors for inpatients will receive a visitor badge which shows the date of their visit. This badge must be worn at all times and is required for same-day re-entry.
- Overnight stays must be approved by the House Supervisor. Approved overnight visitors must return to the main entrance each day at 7 AM to receive a new visitor badge.
- Facemasks must be worn at all time while in the hospital, including while in patient rooms. Cloth masks should be at least 2 layers. If you require a hospital supplied mask, please reuse until visibly soiled.
- Stay in the patient's room at all times except to visit the restroom or cafeteria. If you are asked to leave the patient's room for a procedure, please use the department's designated waiting area.
- Follow social distancing, and wash hands or use hand sanitizer frequently.
- Provide updates to family members who are not currently visiting.
- Notify hospital staff immediately of any changes to your health.
