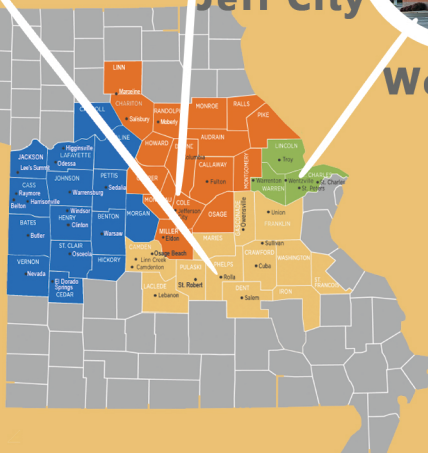

The goal of the Crisis Stabilization Centers is to provide a safe and less costly alternative to divert individuals arrested, away from jail and emergency rooms and into treatment services. These services would allow for further observations, connecting the individual to ongoing care, and avoiding inpatient admission.



Access To Care

The crisis centers will be a 24/7/365, no wrong door entry program that provides rapid access to triage, stabilization services, and linkage to appropriate community services for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis.



Our Team

Our staff will be a multi-disciplinary team that includes registered nurses, case workers, mental health technicians, licensed qualified mental health professionals and psychiatrists/nurse practitioners.
