

**CITY OF GLASGOW, MISSOURI
LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, a Declaration of Emergency has been executed pursuant to Chapter 225 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 225 of the City Code authorizes the Mayor to exercise certain exceptional powers due to an emergency, including the authority to govern the City by proclamation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH Chapter 225 of the City Code, I, Donald Clear, Mayor, hereby proclaim the following:

1. On or about the 27th day of April 2026, a weather event occurred in the City of Glasgow causing substantial damage to include downed power lines, damage to buildings and roofs, as well as substantial damage to the water tower.
2. This event has caused use of City streets or other areas in the City of Glasgow difficult or impossible.
3. This event has caused the City of Glasgow to be without power and water, which impacts all of the service to the City.
4. The entire City of Glasgow is now under a Local State of Emergency.
5. The provisions of this proclamation shall be in effect immediately and remain in effect for seventy-two (72) hours unless expressly extended by proclamation for another period or removed sooner.
