PROPOSITION 2 FOR PHASE 2

Shall the Board of Education of the Blair Oaks R-II School District, Missouri, with no estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Nine Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$9,250,000) for the purpose of providing funds to complete Phase 2 of the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of the new high school; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District and prepay principal on the existing lease financing; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.2100 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

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PROPOSITION 3 FALCON FUTURE

Shall the Board of Education of the Blair Oaks R-II School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$0.3000 to \$3.3500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the purposes of competitively attracting and retaining quality certified and support staff and meeting additional operating expenses?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating tax levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.3000 from \$3.0500, currently, to \$3.3500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the 2024 Tax Year and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter.
