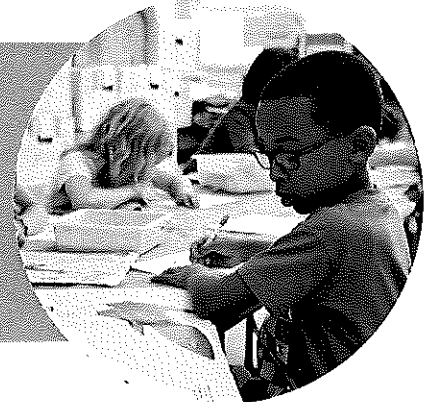
Ask About Behavioral Health Services at your Child's School
