## Motion 2: Request to MU Chancellor and UM System President Mun Choi to extend masking mandate

Faculty Council requests that the Board of Curators **renew** the current requirements for face coverings before they expire on October 15<sup>th</sup> **and**,

to reduce confusion and increase safety,

that they *revise* the mask policy to require that everyone wear face coverings [meeting current campus standards](#) in every indoor public space on campus, including classrooms, meeting rooms, hallways, and office spaces where an individual cannot close their door

## Motion 3: Recommendation to MU Chancellor and UM System President Mun Choi for Vaccination Requirement

Whereas available vaccines against Covid-19 are [the most important tool in preventing COVID-19 and its spread](#).

And [The State of Missouri's Department of Health & Senior Services](#) states that authorized COVID-19 vaccines can help protect you from COVID-19 and recommends individuals should receive the [COVID-19 vaccine](#) when it is available to them

And a recent [survey of faculty](#) shows that **85% of Faculty** think that members of the University community should be vaccinated against Covid-19 and **74% of Faculty** support requiring vaccinations against Covid-19 for all employees and students who do not have a medical or religious exemption

Be it resolved that

The MU Faculty Council on University Policy requests that the Board of Curators for the University impose a COVID-19 vaccination mandate for all faculty, staff, and students, such mandate to be (a) comparable in scope to the one already adopted by MU Health Care on August 6, 2021; and (b) implemented prior to the beginning of the Spring 2022 Semester.
