

Angola welcomes 3Rivers Federal Credit Union



ANGOLA – The fastest growing credit union chain in Indiana held a grand opening for its Angola location in May.

3Rivers Federal Credit Union, 2889 Boyer Way, officially opened its doors at the end of 2020 but hadn't yet held an official ribbon cutting and grand opening celebration due to the pandemic.

President and CEO Don Cates said it took them a long time to get to Angola, as the credit union has wanted to come to the area for quite some time.

"We are super proud to finally be here," he said. "We're excited to share this beautiful facility and our services with Steuben County."

Since the beginning of 2021, Cates said they have closed on \$3.3 million in loans.

"We are the fastest growing credit union in Indiana," he said.

Wanting the Angola branch to have a lake community vibe, artwork in the building was crafted by local artists including Commissioner Lynne Liechty, who was present Friday for the ribbon cutting. "We wanted local art to depict the community and to support local artists," Cates said.

He also talked about what makes 3Rivers unique.

"The mayor doesn't lack for financial institutions in Angola," Cates said. "There have probably even been ribbon cuttings lately that others have said similar."

What makes the credit union unique, Cates said, is the desire to want members to not only be financially well, but also socially well, which will lead them to overall wellness, including from a health standpoint.

"You have to know where you are right now to start a financial wellness journey," he said. "Think about that as you drive ... that's why we're here, to help people get from where they are to where they want to be."

Mayor Richard Hickman thanked the company for investing in Angola and wanting to call the community home for a branch.

The investment made in putting a branch in

Angola totaled \$1.8 million for the 2,800 square-foot building that is complete with three drive-through lanes and an ATM.

"We know you've done your due diligence and studies to know our community is growing," said Hickman. "We know you can help provide quality of life and we are excited to welcome you to Angola and look forward to a great partnership together."

The Angola branch offers full-service banking including mortgage, business and investment services.

"This expansion not only supports our existing membership, it gives us the space to help even more people and businesses with their financial needs," said Cates. "Moving to Steuben County has been a long time coming and we've been grateful for the warm welcome."

3Rivers Federal Credit Union is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

"We appreciate you being here," He said. "You will help people have a better quality of life and a better retirement."





Chuck Sheets: An Angola Icon





ANGOLA – Sheets LP Gas was inspired by the grandfather of Angola icon Chuck Sheets.

"My grandfather was a Standard Oil agent," said Sheets in an interview with Chamber Board Member Ron Weimer. "He had a team of horses and a tank and delivered kerosene and some stove and lighting oil."

His grandfather lived in town in Angola and Chuck's father was an only child.

Chuck himself had one brother, Bill, that was 10 years younger than him.

The family formed the Sheets Oil Company in the early 1930s. They ran service stations for some time, then got into selling tires and other equipment.

"We had a rather large fuel oil business," Sheets said. "Natural gas came in and of course we had a lot of that."

Propane came on, and the family got into the propane business.

"We grew with that," said Sheets. "We enjoyed a good length of time with the propane industry."

Chuck got involved with the family business, driving the fuel truck in town, around age 15. It was during the war and he was operating on a special drivers license.

If his father taught him one thing about becoming a businessman, Sheets said he guessed it would be never misrepresent yourself or your products and try to always give good service.

"We kind of changed with the petroleum industry as we were as a small operation," Sheets said. "Propane replaced a lot of the other facets of the petroleum industry."

When his brother died from cancer, Sheets purchased Bill's half of the company from his sister-in-law.

Sheets has two daughters, both of whom spent some time working in the office.

His wife, Ruth Ann (Tusie) Sheets didn't spend much time working in the office. As Sheets said, she kept busy with the girls.

Being involved in the community was just a natural part of being a business owner in the community for Sheets. Being always from the area, his family was active in the area as well and it was something he always knew.

"I didn't know any different," he said.

Among other things, Sheets was a big part in the start up of the YMCA of Steuben County, the Steuben County Community Foundation and the Heritage Club of Steuben County.

Each was a passion he ran with, along with others in the community, to bring the ideas to life to support local projects and quality of life.

Even now he continues to support Steuben County and its people, giving back to the community he loves.

Heritage Club opens for Senior Citizens

ANGOLA - The Heritage Club of Steuben County opened in September 2020 for those 60 and better.

A ribbon cutting was held for the club, the home of the Steuben County Council on Aging, with Lt. Gov. Suzanne Crouch being given the honor of cutting the ceremonial ribbon in front of a crowd that easily topped 200 people.

"You all have achieved great success here in Angola and Steuben County," said Crouch. "You are honoring our seniors by giving them the quality of life they have earned and that they so deserve."

The new building has been a long time coming for the 45-year old organization.

Chuck and Ruth Sheets donated the land for the new building and Ralph and Sheri Trine donated the construction of the building to help make the dream for so many a reality.

Angola Mayor Richard Hickman said he recalls how excited the senior community was when it was able to get into the Steuben Community Center, which was the organization's home for more than 20 years.

"And now to have this," he said, gesturing to the new building. "This is how we treat our senior citizens."

He said you can grade a community on how well it treats its seniors, and the new facility was a testament to how Steuben County values its older citizens.

He thanked both the Sheets and Trine families for all they have done to contribute to the facility and the community.

In 2015, the COA board talked about a fundraiser when one member asked if the others knew what they were doing, said Board President Karen Shelton.

"We said well no," Shelton said. "But we knew what we wanted."

That first fundraiser was a Dancing with the Stars event that, at the end, a \$5,000 check was given that made them feel like they were rich.

"We were off," Shelton said. "I have since been in every building, on every empty lot in Steuben County."

Then one afternoon, local real estate agent



Fred Beck called and told her the Sheets family wanted to donate the corner of Wohlert Street and Harcourt Road, to the tune of about four acres, for a senior center.

"I was like 'that corner?' I've been by this corner a lot and thought it would be a pretty place for a senior center," Shelton said. "After that I had lunch with Sheri Trine ... she said we are going to help."

The Sheets and Trine families got together, and Shelton said Chuck Sheets told her when Sheri Trine gets involved to just get out of the way and let her go.

Sheri later told Karen, "Honey, Ralph and I did some talking and we're just going to build that building for you."

By October 2019, ground was broken for the building that opened at the end of August for activities for the senior citizens.

"The real stars today are the seniors," Shelton said. "These are the folks who have given, been patient, not complained and so today we give this to you. Use it, enjoy it, it belongs to you."

Kreais said she was the one dropped in the middle of greatness between Shelton and Sheri Trine. Kreais took her position in April 2019.

"These seniors have waited so many years to see this dream come to fruition and here we stand today," Kreais said.

The whole process, she said, has been a wonderful ride.

She thanked each person and group that were involved in the varying ways during the project including the Sheets and Trine families, A&D Specs, project manager Matt Clemens and the rest of the team from Vestil Manufacturing that worked on the

center, Todd Wells for all of his work from the ceiling to the floors, furniture and more as well as Shelton and her determination.

Kreais also said she couldn't go without recognizing the STAR Transportation garage.

The new garage, she said, is bigger than what they at one time had anticipated for the entire senior center.

A lot of work from a lot of important people, she said, went into that as well.

Shelton went to the Hamilton Lions Club and talked about what they wanted to see.


"We got a phone call the next day from Bob Howard who said we had a meeting with the past international president Wayne Madden and we want to help with the transportation garage," Kreais said. "So from there all six Lions clubs have been meeting monthly to fund the STAR Public Transportation facility."

A grant was written to Lions Club International and they banded together to raise funds to continue to support STAR not just through the build, but ongoing, Kreais said.

Madden passed away just before finding the grant was approved, but Kreais said in his honor and memory a plaque will hang on the front of the building.

The grant had a match that was fronted by two township trustees, Jamestown Township Trustee Angela Corcimiglia and Pleasant Township Trustee Mike McClelland. Kreais said she wanted to make sure they also received thanks for their contributions.



Those objectives are business retention and expansion, attraction, workforce development and public-private partnerships. Since 2016, we have been active in more than 83 projects in the community, and of those 34 are new businesses. All the rest are expansionprojects of local businesses. We are taking care of those already here in our community.

The COVID-19 pandemic moved some things virtual, including Manufacturing Day. Also because of the pandemic, SCEDC analyzed and reported labor force impacts and recovery results regularly. As 2021 continues, the SCEDC plans to continue building a robust retention and expansion process, develop marketing collateral to support target industries, continue to build awarenessa round local opportunities for all workforce levels and will continue to facilitate opportunites to collaborate in public-private partnerships.



Not a bad state

ANGOLA – Angola Mayor Dick Hickman presented his annual State of the City address this spring, focusing on how the city met the challenges of a global pandemic head on and is well-positioned for the future.

The fifth-term mayor praised city employees for ensuring the continuation of municipal services and thanked local first responders, medical workers and teachers for their actions to keep the community safe.

COVID-19 was a dominant theme, as Hickman talked about how the city of Angola was forced to adapt to a new threat, but overall saw lots of positive things happen in 2020.

"In preparing this year's state of the city, I thought it would be one of the most difficult speeches I've written because of the pandemic," the mayor said in the opening lines of his speech, which came near the end of Monday's city council meeting. "But that wasn't the case, because in looking back a great many projects were completed and many future projects have been coming through my office.

"During last year's State of the City the COVID-19 pandemic was not even mentioned, yet shortly after that speech it took over our lives and how we as a city were going to do business," Hickman said. "COVID-19 hit our employees just like it has every sector of our society.

"I am very appreciative at how our elected officials and our employees have worked very hard to adjust their lifestyles and their work schedules so that we can maintain a business-as-usual working environment in our city."

City finances remain favorable

Hickman reported that Angola continues to maintain a strong financial position, with a checking and cash balance of nearly \$2.2 million and more than \$19 million in savings and reserve funds.

Included in that number are \$1.5 million in a "rainy day fund" and a \$2.9 million balance in Angola's Major Moves Fund.

Plenty of new development Despite it seeming like the pandemic



had ground everything to a halt, city staff remained very busy.

"In 2020 we had 130 new construction permits totaling \$23,484,333. This is a \$5,870,487 increase over 2019," Hickman said. "There were 22 single family home permits with a total value of \$5,692,742."

"Our Planning and Economic Development Department worked on 17 different projects this past year helping our businesses and industries grow."

Park usage increased

In early 2020, Angola's Parks and

Recreation Superintendent Matt Hanna, thought the pandemic might result in a lost year for public recreation opportunities, Hickman said.

However, the complete opposite turned out to be true.

"Matt said that he actually felt there was more park usage in 2020 than he had seen in his 20 years of involvement with our parks," the mayor said. "More people were utilizing our outdoor pavilions by meeting with 2 or 3 people meeting for coffee or lunch in different areas of our parks."

"The trails were being used more as people were tired of being isolated indoors. The new disc golf course was busy all summer long with new and advanced users making the most of this new outdoor facility."

Hickman said the Angola Parks and Recreation Department is looking forward to life hopefully getting back to normal in the coming months.

Positive post-pandemic outlook

"In summary, the pandemic did affect how we do our jobs, but it did not stop us from doing our jobs," Hickman said near the end of his speech. "We were not able to have many of our celebrations. But we were still able to provide all the needed services to our citizens."

The mayor said that based on his experience of 20 years in office, he understands that unpredictable events like 2020's coronavirus pandemic create winners and losers.

Hickman said all of the economic development activity happening throughout the city, and the tremendous work of its city staff, have convinced him that Angola will emerge from the pandemic a "winner."

"And in doing so, the city of Angola will continue to be the city that is 'working together to make visions a reality," he said.

Steuben EDC highlights 2020

ANGOLA – The Steuben County Economic Development Corporation saw eight projects to date in 2020.

Since 2016, more than 80 projects have come through the EDC, with more than \$333 million in total investments made between real and personal property.

Just under 10,000 jobs have been retained, with approximately 775 created.

Target industries continue to be advanced manufacturing, transportation and logistics, biomedical, alternative energy, information technology and construction.

In a presentation prepared by the SCEDC, it says the target industries are identified as areas they focus on when submitting sites and buildings for leads.

"We are also monitoring our availability of employees in these industries considering our low unemployment rate," said the presentation.

Introduced to area manufacturers in 2020 was a pre-manufacturing academy launching in 2021. The academy program will be for high school students interested in a manufac-

turing career.

Manufacturers will sponsor students for the academy, with that sponsorship compensating the student during their time in the academy.

Private sector funding was down some in 2020 due to COVID-19. However, more than \$75,000 was raised for projects that include a housing project, fiber extension to the EDC, energy consulting, website and attraction marketing and a collaborative DeKalb grant.

The SCEDC also assisted more than 20 companies with tax abatements, with more than 65 currently throughout the county.

Other achievements for the SCEDC include being selected as a Top 50 Economic Developer in North America by Consultant Connect, being awarded \$100,000 from RDA for a second round, Lt. Gov. Suzanne Crouch's attendance at a coworking space groundbreaking at the SCEDC, being recognized as a Top 10 Micropolitan in 2019 and 2020, and being ranked seventh best county by Fourth Economy, and Steuben was the only county in Indiana included on the list.

The SCEDC will continue to work on its four major objectives in 2021.

Cameron at forefront of new women's health procedure

ANGOLA – Cameron Memorial Community Hospital's Dr. Todd Rumsey is the first physician in the U.S. to perform a commercial Cerene cryoablation, an important procedure



for women who suffer from excessive menstrual bleeding.

My takeaway is that patients can now reliably seek treatment for their heavy menstrual bleeding in the familiarity of their physician's office versus the hospital or ASC setting," Rumsey said.

The Cerene device was developed with feedback from leading clinicians and is indicated for endometrial cryoablation in premenopausal women with heavy menstrual bleeding due to benign causes for whom childbearing is complete. Cryoablation is a well-characterized, durable therapy routinely used to ablate malignant and benign human tissues. In the uterus, the use of cryothermic energy has been shown to reduce the likelihood of scarring and intrauterine adhesions while preserving the possibility to adequately evaluate the endometrial cavity in most patients to diagnose and treat future intrauterine conditions. The team at Channel Medsystems has integrated the cryothermic energy delivery system into a disposable,

self-contained, ergonomic device, eliminating the need for capital equipment.



Carnegie Library gets renovation work

ANGOLA – Significant renovations are coming to the Carnegie Public Library, especially when it comes to the basement of the building, with a tentative completion of fall 2021.

Design plans received board approval and bids went out in the fall.

Zachary Benedict with MKM Architecture and Design, Fort Wayne, presented plans via Zoom last fall that included new meeting rooms, new lounge space, new storage space and an update to the children's department that includes a new space just for teens.

Library Director Sonya Dintaman said it has been the plan to finish the basement for a few years.

"We've been thinking about how to best utilize that space over the last five years or so," she said. "Since more materials are available digitally or from other Evergreen Indiana libraries, we don't need more space for materials."

She said, however, that the library has always been a meeting space with the need for smaller meeting areas for small groups, professionals meeting with clients, quiet study space and a flexible space for larger groups.

The library has two meeting rooms with a need for more.

"We're constantly juggling the two rooms we have and have put a table in the basement elevator foyer to accommodate some of the needs," she said. "The basement renovation will meet our needs with many kinds of uses at the same time."

Benedict said the basement renovation plan will include three new meeting rooms that will have sound-absorbing partitions that can be moved to make the space one large meeting room, capable of accommodating around 150 people.

There will also be two smaller meeting



rooms in the basement, lounge space, a new study lounge and updated restrooms. The basement will also have a secure storage area.

Work on the first floor of the library will include updates to the restrooms and the new teen lounge space.

"We're excited about having a dedicated space for teens that will be separated from the children's area," Dintaman said.

Dintaman said there are two alternates being bid on the project to give some flexibility, depending on how construction bids come back.

The alternates include other work in the children's department and work in the staff book drop room.

The other project that will be done to improve the library is the addition of a metal roof that Dintaman said will eliminate problems the library has had in the past with the roof and maintenance costs.

To fund the work, the library is selling \$2.5 million in bonds.

Easterseals-RISE merge together

ANGOLA - RISE Inc. was founded in the fall of 1965 as the Community Sheltered Workshop in the basement of Pleasant Lake Elementary School.

Since then, it has served disabled adults through a variety of services and locations, now in its permanent home at 1600 Wohlert St., Angola.

On July 1, 2020 RISE merged with Easterseals Arc of Northeast Indiana. Its name changed to Easterseals RISE but its focus and its services did not change, said RISE Executive Director Chris Stackhouse before the merger.

"We don't anticipate any big changes," he said. "No current services will be taken away from anybody."

The Angola facility serves Steuben and DeKalb County individuals, providing everything from 24-hour care to employment opportunities.

"We do some pretty cool recreational stuff," said Stackhouse, recounting trips to Pokagon State Park and skating parties at the Thunder Ice Arena.

While RISE is a boon to the community,



Stackhouse said its business model wasn't working.

"We just want to serve our clients," he said. "Here we are. Even in a pandemic, we are doing it."

Based in Fort Wayne, Easterseals Arc of Northeast Indiana has been serving people with disabilities and special needs and their families for 65 years.

Donna Elbrecht, president and CEO of Easterseals Arc of Northeast Indiana, who grew up waterskiing on the Lake James chain of lakes, said the merger will provide additional opportunities for post-graduate students and hands-on work opportunities.

Other additional services offered by Easterseals RISE include behavior counseling with masters-degree-level therapists, more young adult and respite services and summer programming.

Easterseals RISE wants to reach out into the local business community and create partnerships, Elbrecht said. Easterseals RISE also will coordinate efforts with local schools.


Donors who have supported RISE can be assured that their funding will continue to be used for local efforts, said Stackhouse. Some Fort Wayne leaders are providing funding for the merger, said Elbrecht.

Stackhouse and Chief Program Officer Crystal Stavitzke will stay in their positions while gaining administrative support from Easterseals Arc. The existing RISE staff will remain employed and get raises.

"We're here to make things better," said Elbrecht.

An open house, stakeholder meetings and other outreach are planned.




