After dinner take a stroll down to Classic City Creamery for an Ice Cream cone and head on over to the Courthouse Park have a seat and enjoy the soothing sound of the waterfall as you finish off your ice cream cone. Wander around the court house square as you stretch your legs before heading back for a good night's sleep.

Friday: Relish the moment of a perfect morning cappuccino at 9th Street Brew with a homemade muffin or gourmet breakfast.

Now you are ready to really start your day. Send the men to the Auburn Cord Duesenberg, NATMUS Ford V-8 or DeKalb County Horseman's Museum so you ladies can explore the fabulous boutique shops of downtown Auburn.

Shopping is plentiful starting on the South end of the historic district with Forget Me Not, All

Beer or wine not your thing, or you have the family with you, head back to 9th Street Brew for the Friday night dessert night special, no matter what the

evenings feature is you will be delighted with the offering before heading off to bed.

Saturday: Just a brisk 15-minute breathtaking walk down North Main Street as you admire all the beautiful historic homes on your way to the North Main Street Diner for a huge made to order breakfast as you sit on the old soda shop style stool. Enjoy the Auburn Farmer's Market and take home some fresh produce, homemade goodies or a beautiful piece of local art. Don't miss out on a treasure-trove of collectables by stepping into The Blue Fruit Jar antique store, experience not just on floor jam packed with antiques and collectables, but be sure to check out the basement.

Today is the day to enjoy the summer art that you most likely passed while shopping or finish the shopping you didn't get to yesterday. Each summer the Auburn Main Street and DABA (Downtown Business Association) work together to bring a summer art project to our downtown. This art trail will lead you to the beautiful historic Eckhart Library. Even if you don't plan to use

your library card step inside to appreciate the architecture and breath-taking stain glass windows. On your way out the back check out the over 100-year-old stunning water fountain.

Just when you thought you were done shopping you have one more clothing boutique to explore. Head down South Jackson Street to Betsy's Boutique. By this time, you might be ready for a bite to eat. Have you ever had the famous Brown House Coney Dog or chocolate shake? Grab an order to go and take it to the Eckhart Park and sit a picnic table and enjoy a little down time. If you would rather have a seat inside to eat, check out Sandra D's Italian or the Auburn House family style plate of fried fish.

The Auburn Cord Duesenberg Museum is open until 5 and it is just down the street from Eckhart Park. The old cars and the history is enough to fill the late afternoon, but the glory of the building itself is a gem to be seen. If you are lucky, you may just see a celebrity checking out Auburn's car history.

Back to your headquarters to

freshen up before you stroll off to dinner. May we suggest The Auburn City Steakhouse not only for an absolutely extraordinary upscale gourmet dinner in the city's old hardware store so, the ambiance is phenomenal too! 




