





To drive a boat with a motor of 10 horsepower or greater one must be at least 15 years old. Those older than 18 need a driver's license or state-issued photo identification card. For those ages 15 to 17, operators must have completed the official Indiana safe boating course and also must have a state identification card or driver's license.

Generally, lakes less than 300 acres in size have speed limits and do not allow high-speed boating. Many lakes in the county have public access sites. In addition, public access sites are located at the Pigeon River State Fish & Wildlife Area in western







# What is Compost?



Compost is the product resulting from the controlled biological decomposition of organic material that has been sanitized through the generation of heat and stabilized to the point that it is beneficial to plant growth. Compost bears little physical resemblance to the raw material from which it originated.

Compost is an organic matter resource that has the unique ability to improve the chemical, physical, and biological characteristics of soils or growing media. It contains plant nutrients but is typically not characterized as a fertilizer.

From the traditional growing of plants to novel uses in stormwater management and climate change mitigation, the production and use of compost has a bright future!

# **Benefits of Using Compost**

- Improves the soil structure, porosity, and density, thus creating a better plant root environment.
- Increases infiltration and permeability of heavy soils, thus reducing erosion and runoff.
- Improves water holding capacity, thus reducing water loss and leaching in sandy soils.
- Supplies a variety of macro and micro-nutrients.
- May control or suppress certain soil-borne plant pathogens.
- Supplies significant quantities of organic matter.
- Improves cation exchange capacity (CEC) of soils and growing media, thus improving their ability to hold nutrients for plant use.
- Supplies beneficial microorganisms to soils and growing media.
- Improves and stabilizes soil pH.
- Can bind and degrade specific pollutants.
- Can closely simulate the characteristics of wetland soils, thereby encouraging the reestablishment of native plant species
- Can be used with great success as a mulch for erosion control.
- Immature compost also can act as mild herbicides to control weeds.
