The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) released the annual performance report (APR) data for all public and charter school districts in the state of Missouri for the 2024-2025 school year on November 6, 2025. The report includes evaluation of school districts through academic performance, academic growth, ACT, ASVAB, attendance rate, graduation rate, college credit earned by high school students, compliance, and other categories.

The North Platte School District scored 91.9% of all possible points. While the District has consistently scored well in this evaluation, this is the highest percentage of points North Platte has scored in the four years of this evaluation process under sixth version the Missouri School Improvement Plan (MSIP 6). We are proud to share that North Platte finished with the highest percentage out of all KCI districts schools, 2nd of the 79 districts in the Northwest Missouri region, and 35th out of the 553 districts in the state of Missouri. This places North Platte in the top 7% of districts in the state.

This score serves as a strong endorsement of the district and celebration of the effort of all stakeholders within North Platte. The collective effort of teachers, support staff, administrators, school board members, community members, and families who support North Platte education are to be commended.

North Platte has prided itself on strong academic success for a long time. We are appreciative of the great performances by our students and staff. We also recognize our areas for improvement while working to maintain our areas of strength to provide an even better educational experience in the future.
