Boards, Commissions, and Like Entities Annual Report to the Legislature as of June 30, 2025

### Summary

The purpose of this report is to summarize information provided to the Division of Administration (Division) by boards, commissions, and like entities (Boards). Louisiana Revised Statute (R.S.) 24:513.2(E) requires the Legislative Auditor to submit annually to the Legislature a report containing summary financial information and personnel data on Boards included in the database. The statute provides for the Legislative Auditor to report findings and recommendations resulting from an analysis of the information. Our findings and recommendations are categorized as follows:

- Boards & Commissions Website The Boards & Commissions website is located at <a href="https://www.cfprd.doa.louisiana.gov/boardsandcommissions/home.cfm">https://www.cfprd.doa.louisiana.gov/boardsandcommissions/home.cfm</a>
   The accuracy of the information available is solely dependent upon the timeliness and accuracy of the Boards' data entry.
- **Number of Boards Reported** As of June 30, 2025, the website contained information on 489 Boards, which is a net decrease of two from the previous year.
- **Boards Providing No Response** We identified one Board that did not respond to requests for personnel data and financial information. The Division sent notices of noncompliance to the respective legislative committees as required by R.S. 49:1301. The Legislature may wish to consider taking action against Boards that fail to comply with the reporting requirements in state law.
- **Inactive Boards** We identified 19 inactive Boards that do not appear to be fulfilling their established functions. Fifteen of these inactive Boards were also identified as inactive in the prior year. We recommend that the Legislature consider abolishing these Boards or taking other actions (additional legislation, appropriations, or board appointments) to assist them in fulfilling their established function.
- **Board Activity** We identified 37 Boards that reported their status as active but have not reported any meeting notices or minutes subsequent to December 31, 2021. Also, 11 of these Boards have no board members identified on the website. We recommend that the Division continue to

work with these Boards to ensure they are appropriately reporting their status and complying with the reporting requirements in state law to make their meeting notices and minutes available on the website.

 Board Per Diem, Salaries, and Travel Expenses – For fiscal year 2025, Boards budgeted approximately \$1.5 million for Board member per diems, \$2.6 million for Board member salaries, and \$2.6 million for Board member travel expenses.

#### **Boards & Commissions Website**

R.S. 49:1301 requires the Commissioner of Administration to establish and maintain a website containing information on Boards: <a href="https://www.cfprd.doa.louisiana.gov/boardsandcommissions/home.cfm">https://www.cfprd.doa.louisiana.gov/boardsandcommissions/home.cfm</a>.

The accuracy of each Board's self-reported information available on this website is solely dependent upon the timeliness and accuracy of each Board's data entry. As a result, anyone attempting to access information about current budgets or expenses for a specific Board may instead retrieve information that is outdated or inaccurate.

We recommend that the Division continue to work with our office regarding the identification of Boards to be added or removed from the database and the form and content of the database fields. We are available to meet with the Division to discuss updates and/or improvements to the website database.

### Number of Boards Reported

As of June 30, 2025, the website contains information on 489 Boards (see Appendix B), which is a net decrease of two from the previous year. This net figure reflects the addition of 19 Boards and the removal of 21 Boards.

The 19 Boards added include 15 new Boards created during the 2024 legislative sessions and four existing Boards not previously included in the database. Boards added to the database during the year ended June 30, 2025, are as follows: Brookstown Neighborhood Crime Prevention District; Cajundome Commission; Castle Manor Improvement District; Criminal Justice Priority Funding Commission Program; Delmont Neighborhood Crime Prevention District; Ferriday Downtown Entertainment District; Glen Oaks Area Crime Prevention and Improvement District; Lafitte Greenway Economic Development District; Lakeshore Villages Community Development District; Louisiana Music Commission; Louisiana Natural Resources Trust Authority; Louisiana Ports and Waterways Investment Commission; Louisiana Public Defender Oversight Board; Northeast Louisiana Railroad Development District;

Renaissance District; Tall Timber Crime Prevention & Improvement District; University of Louisiana at Lafayette Economic Development District; University Security District; and Victoria Farms Crime Prevention and Improvement Board.

The Shreveport I-20 Economic Development District, created during the 2024 regular legislative session, has not yet been added to the database because the Division has been unable to obtain contact information for the Board.

The 21 Boards removed include eight that were abolished during the 2024 regular legislative session, three that were abolished during prior legislative sessions or have passed the established termination date, two that were removed due to not meeting the requisite requirements for reporting, and eight abolished by an expiration of a former Governor's Executive Order. Boards removed from the database during the year ended June 30, 2025, are as follows: Automobile Theft and Insurance Fraud Prevention Authority Board of Directors; Council on Watershed Management; Governor's Advisory Council on Rural Revitalization; Governor's Advisory Task Force on Atchafalaya River Basin Restoration and Enhancement; Governor's Council on Homelessness; Governor's Task Force on DWI; International Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority Board of Commissioners; LA Commission on HIV and Hepatitis C Education, Prevention & Treatment; Lake Fausse Point, Lake Dauterive, and Grand Avoille Cove Advisory Board; Louisiana Cybersecurity Commission; Louisiana Governor's Mansion Commission; Louisiana Health Care Commission; Louisiana Mandated Health Benefits Commission; Louisiana Small Business and Entrepreneurship Council; North Lafayette Redevelopment Authority Board of Commissioners; Occupational Licensing Review Commission; Property and Casualty Insurance Commission; Public Defender Board; Restore Louisiana Task Force; State as a Model Employer Task Force; and Tax Free Shopping Commission.

The effects of the laws enacted during the 2025 Regular Legislative Session are not reflected in the database as of June 30, 2025. Any new or abolished Boards resulting from the 2025 Regular Legislative Session will be added or removed prior to the 2026 reporting period.

### Boards Providing No Response

R.S. 24:513.2(F) directs all agencies, boards, commissions, and departments of the state and its political subdivisions to furnish information and reports as requested by the Legislative Auditor to fulfill his responsibilities. All Boards were requested to provide contact information, membership information, and statutory or legal authority relative to the entity.

R.S. 39:1335 and 1336 require licensing agencies to provide summary and detailed information pertaining to actual and budgeted revenues by source, expenditures by category, and fund balances; performance indicators; and certain general information pertaining to the Board and its authority and functions.

All other Boards were requested to provide similar information, except that the financial and budget information was requested in summary form only, and information pertaining to performance indicators was not requested.

As of June 30, 2025, the following Board did not respond to requests for personnel data and financial information.

#### 1. Glen Oaks Area Crime Prevention and Improvement District

Purpose or function:	To promote and improve the subdivisions of the Glen Oaks Area and North Baton Rouge, to provide a conduit for citizens and residents to help in the collective efforts of improving our area. To meet the security and beautification standards of all residents within the Crime Prevention and Improvement District (CPID). To institute programs for youth and young adults of the CPID.
Year created:	2023
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9097.39
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.

A joint letter from the Commissioner of Administration and the Legislative Auditor requesting information was mailed to all Boards identified in our report (Appendix B). Numerous requests to the Board listed above were made by the Division's staff to submit the requested information in the database.

In accordance with R.S. 49:1301, the Division sent notices of noncompliance to the Board for failure to respond to its requests. In addition, notice of the Board's failure to respond was sent to the state department of which the Board is a part, the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs, the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs, and the oversight committees for the Board. The Legislature may wish to consider taking action against the Board for failure to comply with the reporting requirements in state law.

### **Inactive Boards**

The following 19 Boards were created by the Legislature prior to the 2024 Legislative Session and were inactive, not fully organized, or disbanded as of June 30, 2025, due to the reasons below, which were obtained from the Board's representative. Fifteen of these Boards were also inactive during the prior year. Because these Boards do not appear to be fulfilling their established functions, the Legislature should consider abolishing them or taking other actions (additional legislation, appropriations, or board appointments) to assist them in fulfilling their established function.

## 1. Advisory Commission for Louisiana's Energy, Environment, and Restoration

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To support programs designed to demonstrate to the general public the importance of the Louisiana oil and natural gas exploration, production, and service industry; encourage the wise and efficient use of energy; promote environmentally sound production methods and technologies; develop existing supplies of Louisiana's oil and natural gas resources; support research and educational activities concerning the oil and gas exploration and production industry; cause remediation of historical oilfield environmental problems; and to have such other authority as provided by law.
Year created:	2020
Legal authority:	R.S. 30:401-403
Date of last meeting:	April 14, 2022
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Commission no longer needed due to fulfilling its specific task assigned and reorganization of the Department of Energy and Natural Resources (DENR) <sup>1</sup> resulting in overlap. DENR recommends the commission be dissolved and that the enabling statute be repealed.

### 2. Advisory Subcommittee of the Accountability Commission \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To report on and make recommendations regarding the overall effectiveness of the teacher evaluation system.
Year created:	2014
Legal authority:	R.S. 17:3883 (A)(6)
Date of last meeting:	June 19, 2015
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	The Commission serves in an advisory capacity only. HB 555 was filed in the 2021 Regular Legislative Session to repeal the statute relative to this subcommittee; however, no action was taken on the proposed legislation.

### 3. Bi-State Corridor Commission

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To provide an information forum on the construction, expansion, improvement, or extension of a route designated U.S. 371, including the fourlane improvements or any portion thereof within the boundaries of the district; the construction of bridges, overpasses, causeways, underpasses, traffic circles, interchanges, and landscaping relating thereto; and the long-term economic/industrial development and tourism development of the corridor area.
Year created:	1991
Legal authority:	R.S. 48:1701
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Commission has no appointed members, and there is no record of the commission ever meeting. Recommended the authorizing legislation be repealed.

### 4. Byways Commission \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	The Federal Highway Administration has changed its procedures. DOTD is the sole agency responsible for reviewing federal byway grants. The Byways Commission was established to assist in this effort which is no longer a responsibility.

Legal authority:	R.S. 56:1948.11
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Commission is no longer necessary, as it has completed its purpose. It is no longer active and should be considered for abolishment by the legislature.

### 5. Dew Drop-America's Rock and Roll Museum Governing Board \*

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To oversee the Dew Drop-America's Rock and Roll Museum.
Year created:	2022
Legal authority:	R.S. 25:380.41 - 380.45
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	No update was provided for the current year.

### 6. Floodplain Evaluation and Management Commission \*

Purpose or function:	To review and revise the statewide flood information database.

Legal authority:	R.S. 38:90.2
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	No funds have been appropriated to carry out the Commission's purpose. A single member was appointed to the commission by the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, & Public Works chair.

### 7. Health Plan Board of Directors \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To provide health insurance to persons with pre- existing medical conditions; establish procedures for the payment of expenses incurred by an administrator in the performance of services; establish procedures for the reporting and remittance of charges assessed; provide for claims paid under the benefit plan and for administrative expenses incurred for the operation of the plan; development of a program to publicize the existence of the benefits plan; and establish procedures for enrollment of members.
Year created:	1990
Legal authority:	R.S. 22:1201 - 1215
Date of last meeting:	December 1, 2023
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	According to the last meeting minutes posted in the database, the Louisiana Health Plan was a dormant corporation and in the process of liquidation. The Board is completely dissolved as of January 13, 2025.

### 8. Housing and Transportation Planning and Coordinating Commission \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To advise the Louisiana Housing Corporation in coordinating the integration of planning and spending by local governments, parish and municipal governing authorities, redevelopment authorities, and the Department of Transportation and Development on housing and transportation needs. The commission shall recommend multiple modes of transportation and multiple types of housing developments to be planned so as to provide planned recreational growth, more fully integrated and livable communities, and effective spending of public funds for the betterment of life for Louisiana citizens.
Year created:	2011
Legal authority:	R.S. 40:600.91 (A)(28)(b)(i)
Date of last meeting:	September 3, 2015
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	The Commission is no longer active. The Joint Committee on Governmental Affairs voted on June 24, 2020, to recommend abolishment of the commission. As of the 2025 Regular Session, no legislation has been passed to abolish this entity.

### 9. Hunting and Fishing Advisory Education Council \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To promote the many benefits of hunting and fishing among Louisiana citizens and to educate the citizens of the state on those benefits.
Year created:	2001
Legal authority:	R.S. 56:699.21
Date of last meeting:	March 7, 2017, according to the board's representative
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Some organizations which have representation on the council no longer exist, and there has been a lack of interest expressed by board members in meetings.

#### 10. LaSalle Cultural Corridor District \*

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To promote, encourage, and enhance the cultural and economic assets of the district through renewed commerce, industry, and utilization and development of the human resources of the area.

Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	No update was provided for the current year.

### 11. Louisiana Music Trail Commission

Status:	Never Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To commemorate and to promote awareness and encourage enjoyment of the stories, biographies, and points of interest in blues, rock and roll, country, zydeco, cajun, jazz, rhythm and blues, hiphop, swamp pop, gospel, and other music types throughout Louisiana.
Year created:	2023
Legal authority:	R.S. 56:1950.21-26
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Louisiana Music Commission was subsequently created and has been formally established essentially duplicating the Louisiana Music Trail Commission's intent.

### 12. Medical Disclosure Panel \*

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To determine which risks and hazards related to medical care and surgical procedures must be disclosed by a physician or other health care provider to a patient or person authorized to consent for a patient and to establish the general form and substance of such disclosure.
Year created:	2012
Legal authority:	R.S. 40:1299.39.6 (reassigned to R.S. 40:1157.2)
Date of last meeting:	March 27, 2015
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	The Board is currently being reinstated; however, it is having difficulties getting members from the various associations to submit their designees. This issue has prevented the panel from holding a meeting.

#### 13. Morehouse Parish Lake Commission \*

Status:	Disbanded
Purpose or function:	Develop a reservoir to provide potable water to Morehouse Parish.
Year created:	2003
Legal authority:	R.S. 38:3087.211
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Other Information:	In 2019, the commission changed its status to "disbanded", and no Board members are currently provided in the database.

### 14. North Bossier Levee and Drainage District Board of Commissioners \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To maintain the existing levee system in a condition that will ensure the integrity and safety to withstand river stages anticipated by design and construction.
Year created:	2009
Legal authority:	R.S. 38:291(J); R.S. 38:301.1
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	During the 2016 Regular Session, Senate Bill No. 148 included language to abolish the board; however, prior to the passage of the bill, the language to abolish the Board was removed. Therefore, the Board still exists, but there are no members.

### 15. Parks and Recreation Commission \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To promote the goals and objectives of the Office of State Parks, to act in an advisory capacity to the Office, and to screen qualified projects for federal grants administered by the Office.
Year created:	1934
Legal authority:	R.S. 56:1681
Date of last meeting:	May 25, 2012
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Commission has been inactive for at least 11 years.

#### 16. Plank Road Business Economic Development Board \*

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	Developing the area included within the district in order to provide for substantial economic activity and employment opportunities.
Year created:	2021
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:2740.67.1
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Board has only had one meeting at which officers were selected. Since that time, the board has not met again nor have members that have left the board since been replaced. It is the intent of the board to reorganize and move forward with the business of the board.

### 17. Small Business Compliance Advisory Panel \*

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To provide advisory opinions to the Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) on the effectiveness of the Small Business Stationary Source Technical and Environmental Compliance Assistance Program.
Year created:	1992
Legal authority:	R.S. 30:2062
Date of last meeting:	August 10, 2011
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Lack of board member appointments. LDEQ wants to move forward and hopes to have a fully functioning advisory panel once the necessary appointments have been made.

#### 18. St. Martin Special Medical District

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To provide for cooperative economic development within the district among the district, the owner or owners of business and property within the district, and any other interested parties, such development endeavors being related to the provisions and expansion of medical services, renovation, restoration, and related ventures.
Year created:	2023
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9038.75
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Board has not been organized.

### 19. State Use Council for Purchase of Goods and Services by Individuals with Disabilities \*

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To coordinate and facilitate the provisions of R.S. 38:2261 which are to ensure state agencies give preference in its purchasing practices to goods manufactured and services performed by individuals with disabilities through supported employment providers, provided such goods manufactured or services performed are equal in quality and reasonable in the rate charged based upon those goods and services available from other providers.
Year created:	2019
Legal authority:	R.S. 39:1604.4
Date of last meeting:	March 8, 2021
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Board is currently listed as inactive while Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) reviews the appropriateness of continuing the program. Changes to the program require legislative action and LDH will pursue changes during the 2026 Regular Legislative Session.

The Water Management Advisory Task Force and the Water Resources Commission, both reported as inactive in the current year, were abolished by 2025 legislation. The Water Management Advisory Task Force and the Water Resources Commission are included in the database as of June 30, 2025 (see Appendix B), but will be deleted from the database prior to the start of the 2026 reporting period.

### **Board Activity**

A Board that has not held meetings for an extended period of time may indicate that the Board is not fulfilling its established function(s) or is no longer necessary. R.S. 49:1302 requires notices and minutes of board meetings to be included on the Boards & Commissions website. The Division has requested all Boards to either post their meeting notices and minutes directly to the Boards & Commissions website or provide a link to meeting notices and minutes that are posted on the Board's own website.

Based on our review of the 463 Boards with a reported status of active, we identified 37 Boards as listed below that have not reported any meeting notices or minutes subsequent to December 31, 2021. Also, 11 of these Boards have no board members identified on the website. We recommend the Division continue to work with these Boards to ensure all Boards are appropriately reporting their status and complying with the reporting requirements to make their meeting notices and minutes available on the Boards & Commissions website.

### Board Per Diem, Salaries, and Travel Expenses

Of the 489 Boards listed in Appendix B, we identified 139 Boards with budgeted payments for Board member per diem, salaries, and/or travel expenses based solely on the information available in the database. The budget amounts presented below in Exhibit 1 reflect the fiscal year 2025 current budget amounts entered in the database by the Boards during the 2025 reporting period unless otherwise indicated. Boards have until May 1, 2026, to enter fiscal year 2026 budgets and fiscal year 2025 actual expenses in the database.
