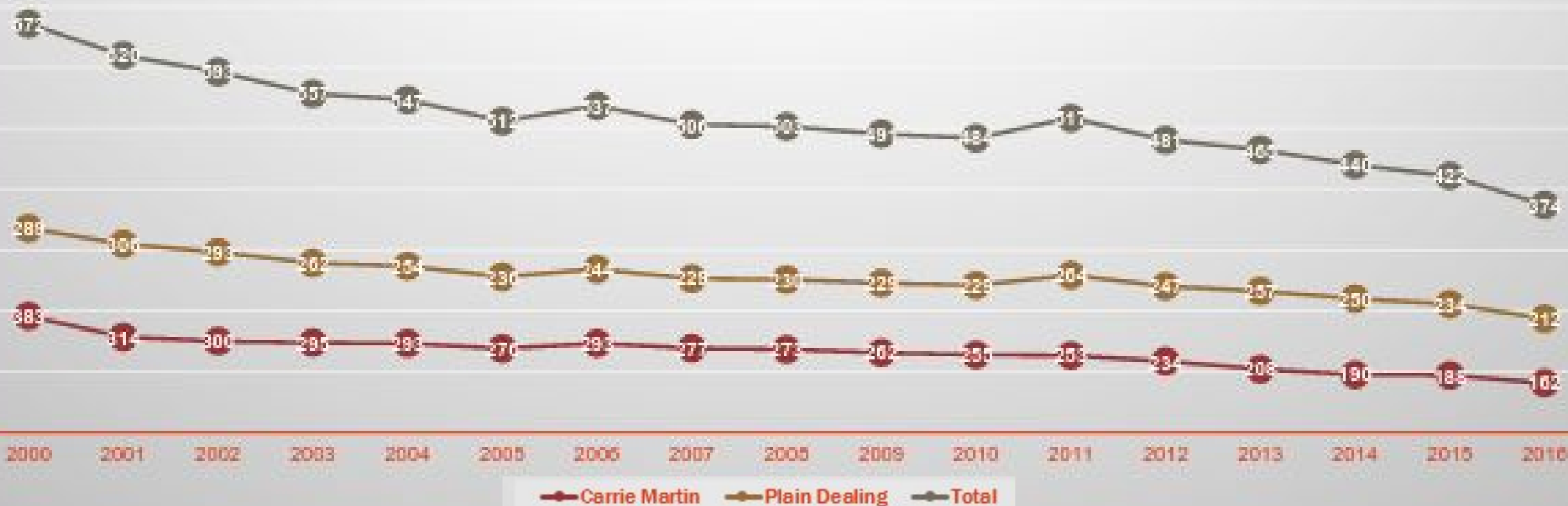

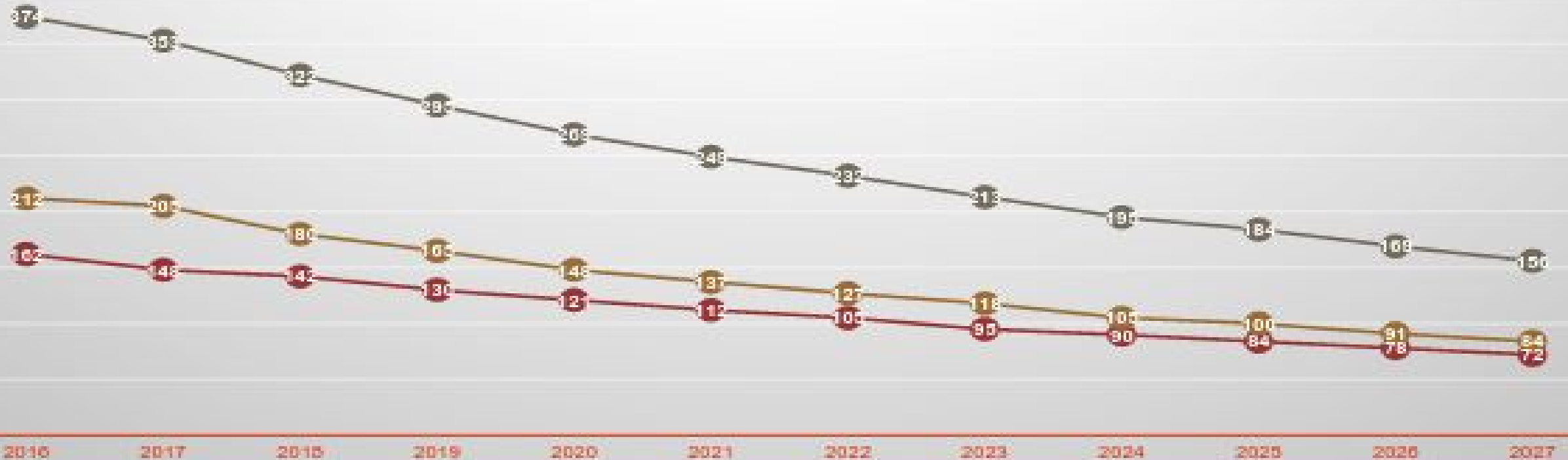

Plain Dealing Pride Proposal

Preschool-12 Reconfiguration

- Site visits were made to other area school districts with Preschool-12 campuses to review their operations
- October 2016 - Jackson Parish School System
 - Weston Preschool-12
- November 2016 - Winn Parish School System
 - Atlanta Preschool-12 Campus

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Grade Separation/Configuration

- Separate elementary, middle and high school students
 - Preschool & Kindergarten in former Cafeteria (maintenance required)
 - Grades 1 - 5 and Special Education in former middle school wing
 - Middle grades 6 - 8 in Activities Building with gym
 - High school grades 9 - 12 in front building with administrative offices
- Breakfast and lunch shifts will need to be scheduled to separate grade levels
- Separate bus drop-off points



Library – PreK & Kindergarten Area

Plain Dealing Pride Preschool Considerations

- Class-size needs to accommodate all the teaching materials in the Carrie Martin Preschool classroom
- Child-size bathroom/water fixtures in restrooms for boys, girls with separate ADA/Staff facilities
- Sink in classroom
- Lockers and/or cubbies with coat hooks



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Preschool Considerations

- Preschool to have separate playground from elementary; Enough land exists by this building for separate playgrounds.
- Provide enough space (ground level) for Preschool and Kindergarten classes with common area provided.
- Entrance/exit for Preschool/Kindergarten is set up to allow movement to cafeteria, buses & car pickup/drop off without any contact with middle and high school

Elementary 1st – 5th to occupy former middle school wing



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1st to 5th Grade Considerations

- Grades 1 - 5 can move to cafeteria, gym, playground, buses and car pickup/drop off with no contact with middle and high school
- Classrooms for Preschool, Kindergarten and Grades 1 to 5 are on one level, with few to no stairs for travel. The only stairs lead to the front office.



Middle School 6th to 8th to occupy Activities Building



Repurpose Band Room



- Convert band room in Activities Building for middle school classroom space

High School 9th to 12th to occupy High School Building



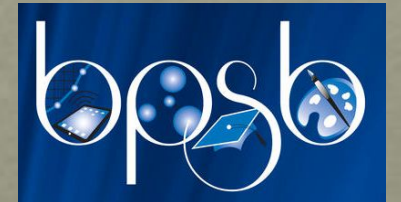
High School Library Conversion

- Repurpose space for 3 classrooms



High School – Jump Start Career and Technical Education

- Jump Start will reactivate local school-based CTE programs at Plain Dealing High.
- Revitalization will enable PDHS to expand CTE offerings to include carpentry/workplace safety.
- Courses will give foundational skills and core certifications.



Exterior improvements

- Install hardscapes and site work
- Install fenced and gated
Preschool/Kindergarten playground
adjacent to ground floor classrooms
- Amenities to include:
 - Track for riding toys
 - Storage for riding toys
 - Soft surface under playground
equipment



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Projected Timeline for Reconfiguration

- Approval of plan by School Board
- Begin phase 1 construction
- Begin phase 2 construction
- Implement Preschool–12 campus model



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
